This week in Physical Education class we played a warm-up tag game called Helping Hands Tag. When a student is tagged they must sit down on the floor and extend both their arms out straight like a letter T and wait for not one, but two students to come to their side and grab their hand or wrist and help them up. Then, staying linked, the three of them run to the center circle (the wellness center) and do 5 jumping jacks. Then they leave the circle and re-enter the tag game.
