FIS School Fees for 2024-2025

Fukuoka International School (FIS) is a non-profit educational institution that relies almost entirely on annual tuition fees to cover operating expenses. The school is subject not only to the increasing cost pressures of operating in Japan but also to competitive forces in the wider international schools' market and international educational resource suppliers. Parents should therefore anticipate some level of increase in annual tuition fees, and financial donations to help enhance school programs and facilities are gratefully accepted.

Tuition: Only Tuition can be paid by installment.

Payment options are;

1. One time payment: Tuition and all annual fees should be paid by the 25th August.
2. 2 installments, one is due by August 25th and the other is due by December 25th
 - a. 1/2 of the annual tuition is due by August 25th which covers the tuition from August to December. (In the case that Re-enrollment Fee was paid in June, this will be 4/10 of annual tuition.)
 - a. The remaining 1/2 of the annual tuition is due by December 25th covering the tuition from January to June.
2. 9 installments (monthly installment), each installment is due on the 25th of the month from August to April.
 - a. 2/10 of the annual tuition is due by August 25th which covers the tuition for August and September. (In the case that Re-enrollment Fee was paid in June, this will be 1/10 of annual tuition which is covering the tuition of September)
 - b. The remaining tuition will be paid in 8 installments. 1/10 of the annual tuition is due by the 25th of each month until April.
 - c. The April payment covers the tuition for May and June.

Application Processing Fee:

Application Processing Fee is to cover the application cost and charged to all applicants and not refundable. Please pay when you apply for admission. In the case of re-enrollment, this will be charged.

Assessment & Observation fee:

Assessment & Observation Fee is to cover the cost of the admission testing and observation, and not refundable. Please pay when you apply for admission.

Admission Deposit:

If you need an official acceptance of admission more than 3 months before your enrollment date, FIS will require a 2-months of tuition as a refundable deposit to ensure a place for the applicant. For example, if they apply in April for an August start and it is accepted, they must pay August and September's tuition up front to ensure a seat in August.

Acceptance fee:

Acceptance Fee is to cover the initial set up of student at FIS. Acceptance Fee is due by the 25th of August and is not refundable. For late enrolment, This Fee is charged in full and should be paid before your enrollment date.

Acceptance Fee will be charged even when re-enrolling. However, the amount is **200,000** yen per student (**Re-acceptance fee**).

Development Fee:

A one-time Development Fee will be charged to all new students when enrolling FIS.

Facility Fee:

The Facility Fee is to maintain and improve the facilities at FIS. Facility Fee is due by the 25th of August and is not refundable. For late enrolment, Facility Fee is charged in full, and should be paid before your enrollment date.

Library Fee:

Library fee is used to upgrade the aging library books and continue to grow the FIS Library. Not refundable. For late enrolment, Library Fee is charged in full and should be paid before your enrollment date.

Graduation Fee: (only for G12 students):

Graduation Fee is to cover the increase costs of grade materials and social events. For late enrolment, Graduation Fee is charged in full and should be paid before your enrollment date.

Accident Insurance Fee:

Accident Insurance Fee is to cover the accident insurance of student at FIS. Accident Insurance Fee is due by the 25th of August and is not refundable. For late enrolment, Accident Insurance Fee is charged in full and should be paid before your enrollment date.

Yearbook Fee:

Yearbook Fee is charged to all students and it is not refundable. Yearbook Fee will not be charged to those who enroll after Yearbook publishing deadline (around Feb or Mar).

Extension Learning Fee & Secondary WWW trip fee:

These Fees are to cover the costs of day-to-day academic field trips and extension learning opportunities during the school year. This fee is not refundable. WWW Trip will not be charged for those who enrolled after WWW trip.

Re-enrollment Fee:

If a current student is re-enrolling for the upcoming academic school year, the first month payment of tuition (1/10 of annual tuition, and will be applied to August tuition.) must be made by March 25th of the current school year in order to ensure a seat for the start of the upcoming school year. This is a refundable deposit towards tuition for the upcoming school year.

Payment

Bank Transfer:

- Please make the bank transfer under **your child's passport name** according to the payment schedule on the school fee bill. The school fee bill will be issued in May for the current students, for new students at the time of enrollment. Please keep your bill until all your payments are completed.
- All bank charges are the payer's responsibility.
- We are very sorry, but payments in cash or credit card are not accepted and automatic deductions are not available.

Receipt:

A school fee receipt will be issued by email from school.fee@fis.ed.jp when payments are received by the school.

Late Enrollment/Early Withdrawal:

Students that enrolls after the First School Day or withdraw from school before the end of the school year then

- All fees except for Tuition will be charged in full.
- In case of late enrollment, the tuition will be charged on a pro-rated basis.
- In the case of early withdrawal, the tuition will be charged until the last day of the month of your child's last school day.
- In case of withdrawal in May and June, there are no refunds. In case of withdrawal, please notify the school office by submitting a "Withdrawal Form", at least 15 days prior to your child/ren's withdrawal day.

Delayed Payments:

In the case of delayed payments, the school policy does not allow the release of report cards, transcripts, letters of reference, graduation diplomas, Yearbook or any other school records to all individuals concerned. If two or more payments are delayed, then the student(s) may be subject to suspension from attending school until all delayed payments are confirmed. Until all payments of the corresponding school year are received by the school, your child(ren) will not be able to attend school the following year. Students with outstanding balances cannot be re-enrolled.
