TOP REASONS TO TRY THE SPORT OF TENNIS

1. Tennis is a Lifetime Sport. You only need one other player (3 if doubles).
2. Tennis is an Individual Sport with a Team Component. You are responsible for your winning/losing. You (or you and your doubles partner) hit every shot. You are involved in every point in your match!
3. Tennis has great expectations for your academic success.
 - a. 2022, 2023, 2024 IHSA Team Academic Award
 - b. 32 out of 41 Eligible Players earned the IHSA Scholastic Achievement Award.
 - c. 2024 Varsity Average GPA - 3.90
4. Boys Tennis understands and supports your commitments for academics including the need to prepare for AP Exams.
5. Boys Tennis supports your participation in other sports and activities.
6. The line-up for tennis is more objective than many sports. If you think that you are better than another player - beat them to earn their spot.
7. Our Coaching Staff includes:
 - a. JV Coach Parola - former Baseball, Current Varsity Golf - Varsity Record in Baseball was 603 + 245. The 2023 JV team (15 + 4) had the best record in Boys Tennis history. "Coach Parola is a force of nature - his programs win".
 - b. Assistant Coach Clausen - All-State Singles player at Grayslake North in 2022. Club Tennis player at Michigan State University.
 - c. Varsity Coach Cohen - Just finished his 40th year coaching tennis. He was inducted into the IHSTCA Hall of Fame in 2020 and was honored with the IHSA Distinguished Service Award in 2019. His career record is 409 + 209.
