

era, there were early settlements and fishing villages. These villages




were along the Pacific coast and Caribbean coast. The Pre-Classic era was from BC 2,500 to AD 250.

Step 1: Fold the paper in half.


Step 2: Unfold the paper and fold each of the top corners into the center line.

Step 3: Fold the top edges into the center line.

Step 4: Fold the plane in half toward you.

Step 5: Fold the wings down, matching the top edges up with the bottom edge of the body.

Step 6: Add double stick tape or a piece of tape wrapped up to the inside of the body Step 7: Let It Fly!
