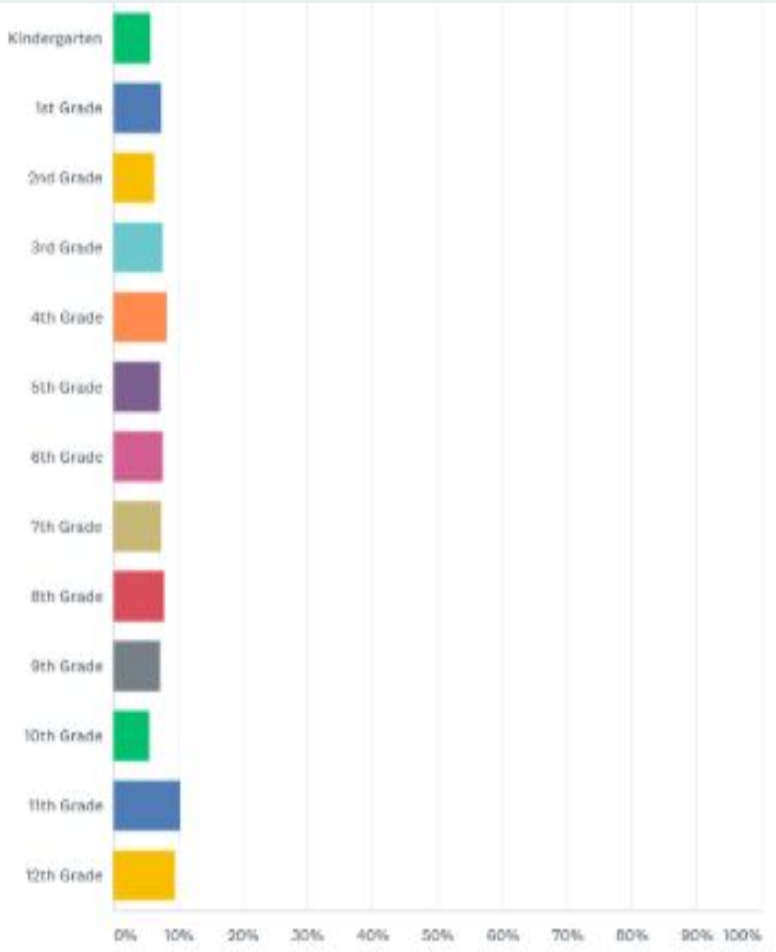


Stakeholder Survey Results

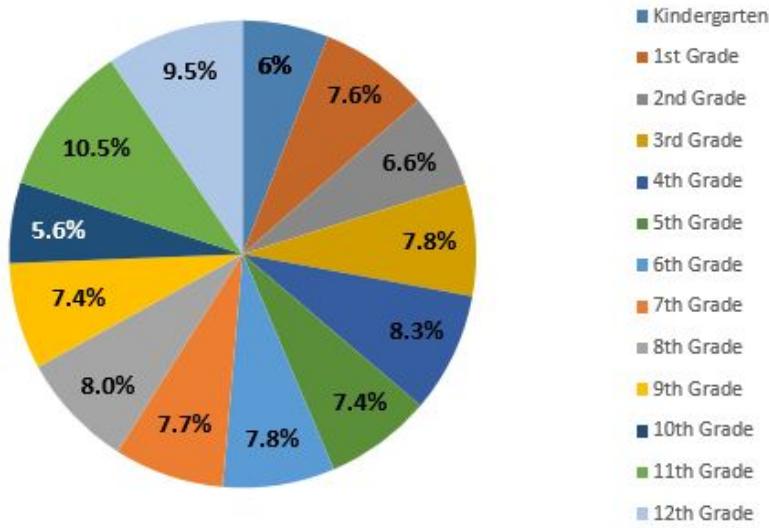


- **A comprehensive parent survey has been implemented to evaluate parent satisfaction / engagement and gather input for the strategic planning process for the school years 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, and 2017-2018 (839 respondents).**
 - 753 respondents (2016-17)
 - 635 respondents (2015-16)
 - 487 respondents (2014-15)
- **For the 2017-2018 school year we implemented for the second time a student satisfaction and engagement survey. Students in the oldest grade of their current building were surveyed (grades 3, 6, 8, and 12) with 1138 respondents.**
 - 1,327 respondents (2016-17)
- **The 2017-2018 school year was the second year for the staff satisfaction survey. From a demographic perspective, we had representation from all employment groups (Act 93, Admin Support, PREA, PRESPEA) with 354 respondents.**
 - 235 respondents (2016-17)

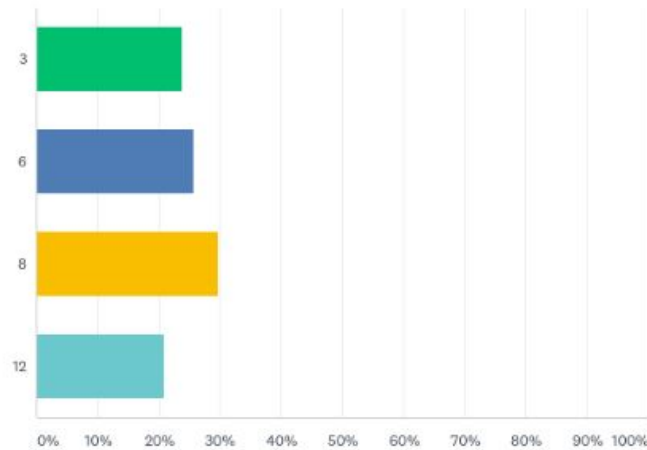

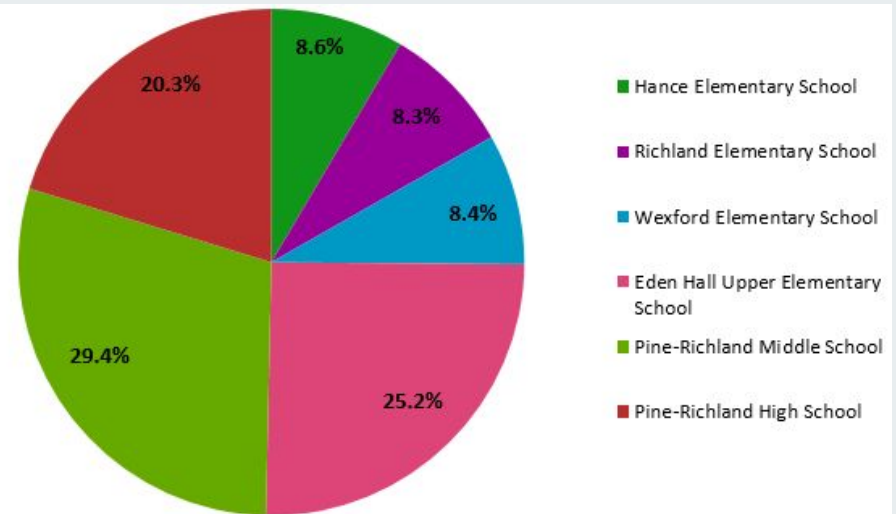

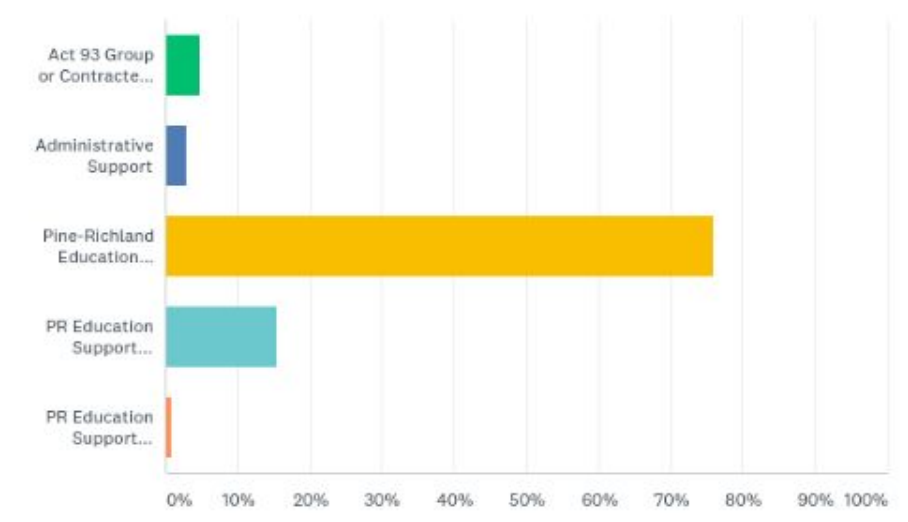

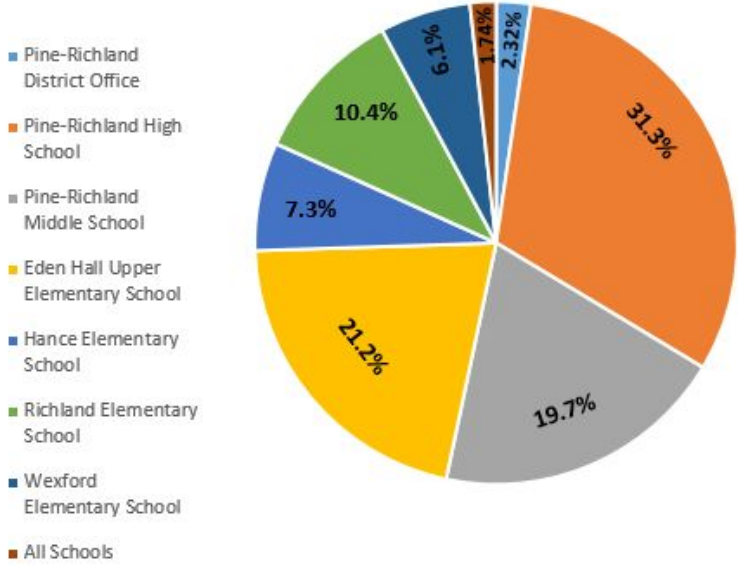
