shaping teen behavior, with about 80% feeling parents should have a say in their alcohol consumption. Binge drinking, defined as 4 or more drinks for females and 5 or more for males in about 2 hours, poses serious risks, including cognitive impairment and lifelong substance abuse issues. 



BVSD Science Symposium: Fairview Hosts 67 Students for Dynamic Science Talks



District (including 15 Fairview students) will be presenting their science and engineering research in 10 minute talks. Nine different sets of talks will all be running at the same time, so there will be a lot of topics to choose from. We encourage students interested in science and engineering research, science fair, and STEM careers to attend, as well as interested members from the Fairview community. Entry will be through the south doors off of the northwest corner of the Senior parking lot (the outside door closest to the Fairview Library). 


BVSD Tree Summit at Fairview- Saturday April 13th
