
Building a Culture of Respect: Fairview High School's Initiative for Sexual Assault Awareness Month

Happy Springtime Knights! April is Alcohol Awareness Month, and it's crucial to address teen drinking, especially with Prom and Graduation approaching. Parents' attitudes play a significant role in



shaping teen behavior, with about 80% feeling parents should have a say in their alcohol consumption. Binge drinking, defined as 4 or more drinks for females and 5 or more for males in about 2 hours, poses serious risks, including cognitive impairment and lifelong substance abuse issues. 


BVSD Tree Summit at Fairview

Colorado to experience particle solar eclipse on Monday

On Monday, Colorado will experience a solar eclipse. While we are not in the path of totality, it is an opportunity for our students to see a natural scientific phenomenon first hand.



The <u>partial solar eclipse</u> is expected to last about 2 hours and 26 minutes:

• Start: 11:28 a.m.

• Peak: 12:40 p.m. with only about 65 percent of the sun covered by the moon

• End: 1:54 p.m.

BVSD believes that first-hand experiences, beyond the classroom, like this, are powerful ways for kids to learn and get excited about science.

Schools in BVSD are encouraged to coordinate safe ways for students to view the eclipse. This may include the use of special glasses or simple pinhole viewers.

In our experience, including the eclipse in 2017, students of all ages have shown that they can participate safely and responsibly. As a result, BVSD schools are not planning to restrict students from outdoor access, including recesses and learning opportunities. We, of course, will be encouraging safe behavior, by providing appropriate safety tips and supervision.

It is important to know that it is never safe to look directly at the sun without special equipment, like solar eclipse glasses, pinhole viewers or telescopes with special filters.

Beware that there have been reports of counterfeit solar glasses. It is important to ensure that any equipment used <u>complies with the ISO 12312-2 international standard for filters for direct viewing of the Sun.</u>

Colorado tendrá un eclipse solar parcial el lunes

El lunes, Colorado experimentará un eclipse solar. Si bien no estamos en el camino de la totalidad, es una oportunidad para que nuestros estudiantes vean de primera mano un fenómeno científico natural.

El <u>Eclipse solar parcial</u> durará aproximadamente 2 horas y 26 minutos:

- Inicio: 11:28 a.m.
- Punto máximo: 12:40 p.m. con sólo alrededor del 65 por ciento del sol cubierto por la luna
- Fin: 1:54 p.m.

El BVSD cree que las experiencias de primera mano, más allá del aula, como ésta, son formas poderosas para que los niños aprendan y se entusiasmen con la ciencia.

Se anima a las escuelas del BVSD a coordinar formas seguras para que los estudiantes vean el eclipse. Esto puede incluir el uso de lentes especiales o cámaras estenopeicas.

En nuestra experiencia, incluyendo <u>el eclipse en 2017</u>, los estudiantes de todas las edades han demostrado que pueden participar de manera segura y responsable. Como resultado, las escuelas del BVSD no planean restringir el acceso de los estudiantes al aire libre, incluidos los recreos y las oportunidades de aprendizaje. Por supuesto, fomentaremos un comportamiento seguro proporcionando consejos de seguridad y supervisión adecuados.

Es importante saber que nunca es seguro mirar directamente al sol sin un equipo especial, como lentes para eclipses solares, cámaras estenopeicas o telescopios con filtros especiales.

Tengan en cuenta que ha habido informes de lentes solares falsificadas. Es importante asegurarse de que cualquier equipo utilizado <u>cumpla con la norma internacional ISO 12312-2 para filtros para</u> la visión directa del Sol.
