- **Treasurer Report:**
 - Financials – Coaches are very happy with the new monthly reports. All savings accounts have been closed out and transferred to respective checking accounts.
 - Board has okayed approvals for all future fast food fundraisers (Oath Pizza, DQ, Chipotle, etc) Coaches no longer have to submit a fundraiser approval form for these events.
- **Secretary Report:**
