Governance

Ms. Chavez stated the Administration recommends approval of today's agenda April 12, 2016 with no modifications or deletions.

1. Consider and approve an order amending an order of the Board of Trustees of Santa Maria ISD calling an election to seek voter approval for the issuance of unlimited tax bonds for the construction and equipping of school buildings in the District and acquiring the sites thereof.

Ms. Chavez stated the administration recommends the amended order that you had already approved in February due to the fact that the voting precinct was extended till 6pm.

Ms. De la Rosa asked if they were amending the time.

Ms. Chavez stated that the original document as prepared by the bond council, Mr. Ramirez, indicated that voting precinct was closing at 5pm and the bond council recommended that it would be best to just go ahead and bring it to the board and to be safe.

Ms. De la Rosa asked why it says for the issuance of unlimited tax bonds. Why unlimited, and what does that mean?

Ms. Chavez stated it's basically the terminology in terms of the resolution and the ordinance on the bond issue. In this case there's a cap in terms of the amount in this case.

Ms. Belinda Lugo clarified that it doesn't mean that they have unlimited amount of money that they can get, it's just the terminology used for the resolution and that bond council recommended.

Ms. Chavez stated that the motion and the order Is based on a set amount that is reviewed by the financial advisor bond council and in terms of what the district qualifies for that amount.
