SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT



1. Presentation of Bond Series by Dr. Miguel De Los Santos, Estrada • Hinojosa Investment Bankers

Superintendent of Schools introduces Rudy Mejia, Assistant Vice President representing - Estrada • Hinojosa Investment Bankers, who joined the company in March 2012.

Mr. Rudy Mejia informs that he will be briefly discuss the Presentation for Plan of Finance for Series 2015 Refunding Bonds and apologizes on behalf of Dr. De Los Santos for not being able to attend. He informs District was looking into refunding back in 2014, but due to delays in audit was postponed. Now that the audit is complete District is now requesting to move forward with financing. Due to postponement interest rates have gone down which is good for the District in regards to savings. We are looking at refunding \$ 1.5 million dollars of the outstanding 2004 bonds, which would produce a savings of about \$ 190,000 and present value savings which represents about 12.5% in present value (PV) savings. Typically when we do a refinancing of those rates anything over 3%, right now the District is four times that amount. That produces about a \$ 12,000.00 savings from 2016-2034. If you look at page three of the presentation it gives you a breakdown of how those savings are allocated per year. We are looking at doing a level savings refinancing, which we will save about \$ 12,000.00 as discussed on page three. On page four of the presentation it goes over who the consultants will be for this transaction. We have Estrada Hinojosa & Company would be your financial advisor, Ramirez & Guerrero LLP will be your Bond Counsel, your Underwriter and Underwriter's Counsel is yet to be determined, and the Paying/Escrow Agent would be Bank of New York Mellon. As it stands right now the timeline it has us pricing the Bonds on March 11th after the board votes today and it's approved tomorrow we will distribute the preliminary official statement to get meetings started and select a Underwriter to get financing under way. Interest rates are really low and market doing great in regards to Bonds. We are requesting approval today to move forward with this.

2. Student/Attendance Enrollment

Superintendent of Schools suggests moving to item three, student recognition and then coming back to student/attendance enrollment.

Returning to the Student/Attendance Enrollment the Superintendent of discusses overall enrollment of 729 with Tony Gonzalez Elementary with 364, Middle School with 164, and the High School with 201.

Overall attendance at this period we are working very closely to recover many students out due to colds.

3. Student Recognition

Superintendent of Schools addresses the parents in the audience and thanks them for their attendance and for student support and their contribution to their success. She asks the Board of Trustees to assist in distribution of incentives for students and asks Mr. Rogelio Campa, TGE Interim Principal to being the student recognition with elementary.

Mr. Campa begins with explaining to the audience the AR Program and how points are achieved by students. He then begins announcing the AR Top readers by grade level, 1st grade AR Top Readers, 2nd grade AR Top Readers, 3rd grade AR Top Readers, 4th grade AR Top Readers, and closes the elementary



campus AR Top Readers recognition with 5th grade AR Top Readers. He congratulates all the AR Top Readers recognized and encourages all the other students to read to achieve AR Top Reader goal.

Ms. Cindy Taylor, Secondary Schools Principal begins student recognition for AR Top Readers for 6th, 7th and closes the Middle School recognition with 8th grade AR Top Readers.

Ms. Cindy Taylor, Secondary Schools Principal begins student recognition for Student of the Week for 9th, 10th, 11th, and closes the High School student recognition with 12th grade Students of the Week.

Ms. Cindy Taylors addresses the parents in the audience and thanks them for their support at home.

4. Board Recognition

Superintendent of Schools informs the audience of Board Appreciation Month and acknowledges our Board service and the amount of time as they serve the school and community of Santa Maria ISD. She informs that the state has selected a theme "A WORK OF HEART" in recognition of the work of Board Members. We know that the work we must achieve is one that requires much time and dedication. She begins acknowledging each individual board member and asks the Administration for assistance in presenting to the Board of Trustees.

Ms. Cindy Taylors informs the audience of student performance in appreciation to Board Appreciation Month, begins the student performance by introducing the Folklorico group.

Mr. Campa continues with student performance and announces the 4th grade students performing to "We are the World" and thanks the teachers, Ms. Martinez, Mr. Pena and Cassandra Taylor for their assistance with our students.

Ms. Cindy Taylor continues with student performance with the Folklorico group and thanks Ms. Vasquez and Ms. Cantu for all their assistance.
