The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the school district's budget that will determine the tax rate that will be adopted. Public participation in the discussion is invited.

Under state law, the dollar amount of school taxes imposed on the residence homestead of a person 65 years of age or older or of the surviving spouse of such a person, if the surviving spouse was 55 years of age or older when the person died, may not be increased above the amount paid in the first year after the person turned 65, regardless of changes in tax rate or property value.

Notice of Rollback Rate: The highest tax rate the district can adopt before requiring voter approval at an election is \$1.237036. This election will be automatically held if the district adopts a rate in excess of the rollback rate of \$1.237036.

Section 551.082	For the purpose of considering discipline of a public school child, or complaint or charge against personnel.
Section 551.083	For the purpose of considering the standards, guidelines, terms, or conditions the Board will follow, or will instruct its representatives to follow, in consultation with representatives of employee groups.

Section 551.084 For the purpose of considering excluding witnesses from a hearing.

Should any final action, final decision or final vote be required in the opinion of the Board with regard to any matter considered in such closed or executive session, then such final action, final decision or final vote shall be at either:

- a. the open meeting covered by this notice upon the reconvening of this public meeting, or;
- b. at a subsequent public meeting of the Board upon notice thereof, as the Board shall determine.
