

UPDATE ON OPERATIONAL ADJUSTMENTS DUE TO STADIUM DEVELOPMENT

12 April 2024

This memo is to inform the OIS community about upcoming changes driven by the development of a new stadium for Stabæk Fotball. This significant project is scheduled for completion by April 2026 and will necessitate adjustments to our routines, some beginning as early as next week.

Long Term Vision

The entire stadium development is scheduled to be completed by April 2026. For an image of the proposed final project, [please see this link](#).

The initial phase, which begins in May 2024 and concludes at the end of November 2024, involves significant infrastructure work that requires the temporary closure of the bus road in front of OIS.

Changes to Drop-Off Locations and Driving Routines

Bus Drop-off: Starting around May 13, 2024, our bus drop-off point will move to Haukeveien at Nadderud Arena. Work will soon begin to improve the pathway between Haukeveien and OIS, and we are developing execution protocols to ensure a smooth transition for all.

Car Traffic and Drop-off: Concurrently, the roadway around the school will be temporarily widened to facilitate two-way traffic, maintaining access for car drop-off.

Road Adjustments Near School

Beginning next week, you may notice the first steps of preparatory work around the school:

Parking Adjustments: There will be a temporary change and realignment of parking spaces, including the creation of a temporary OIS parking lot on the field behind the school, known as "Rismarka."

Traffic Flow Development: The roadway around the school will be widened to support safe two-way traffic. Additionally, a new traffic circle near the skate park will be constructed to facilitate turnarounds.
