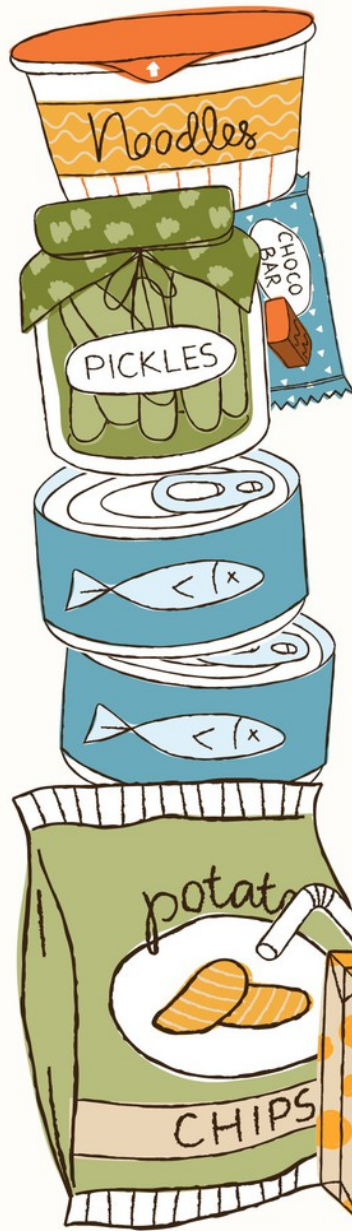


CONTEST GUIDELINES:

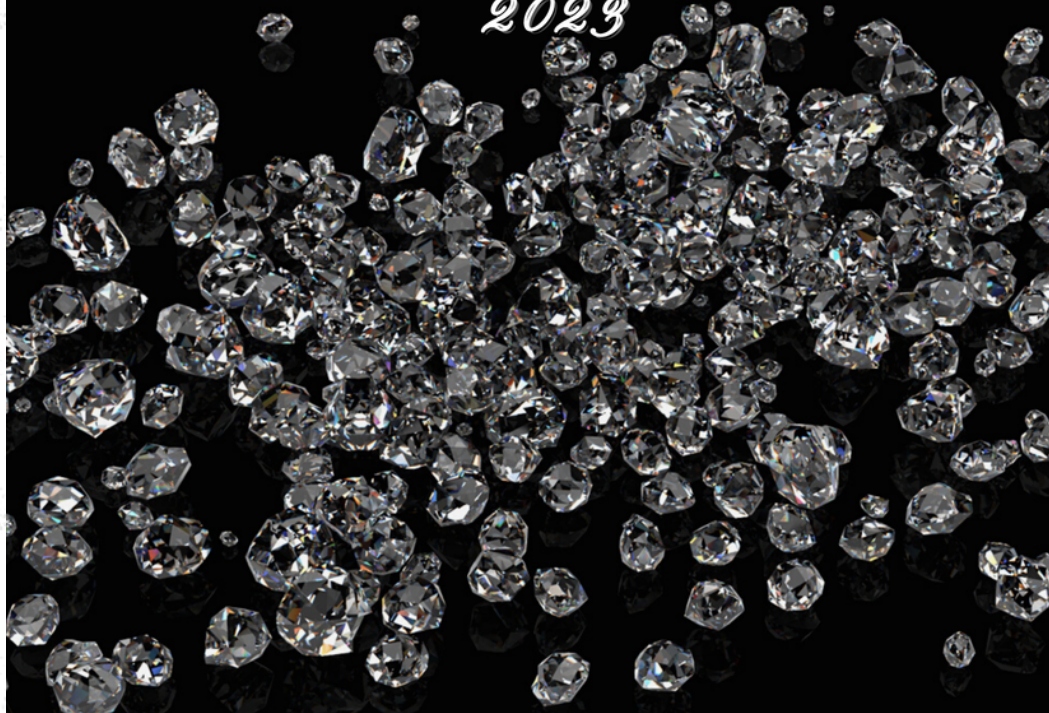

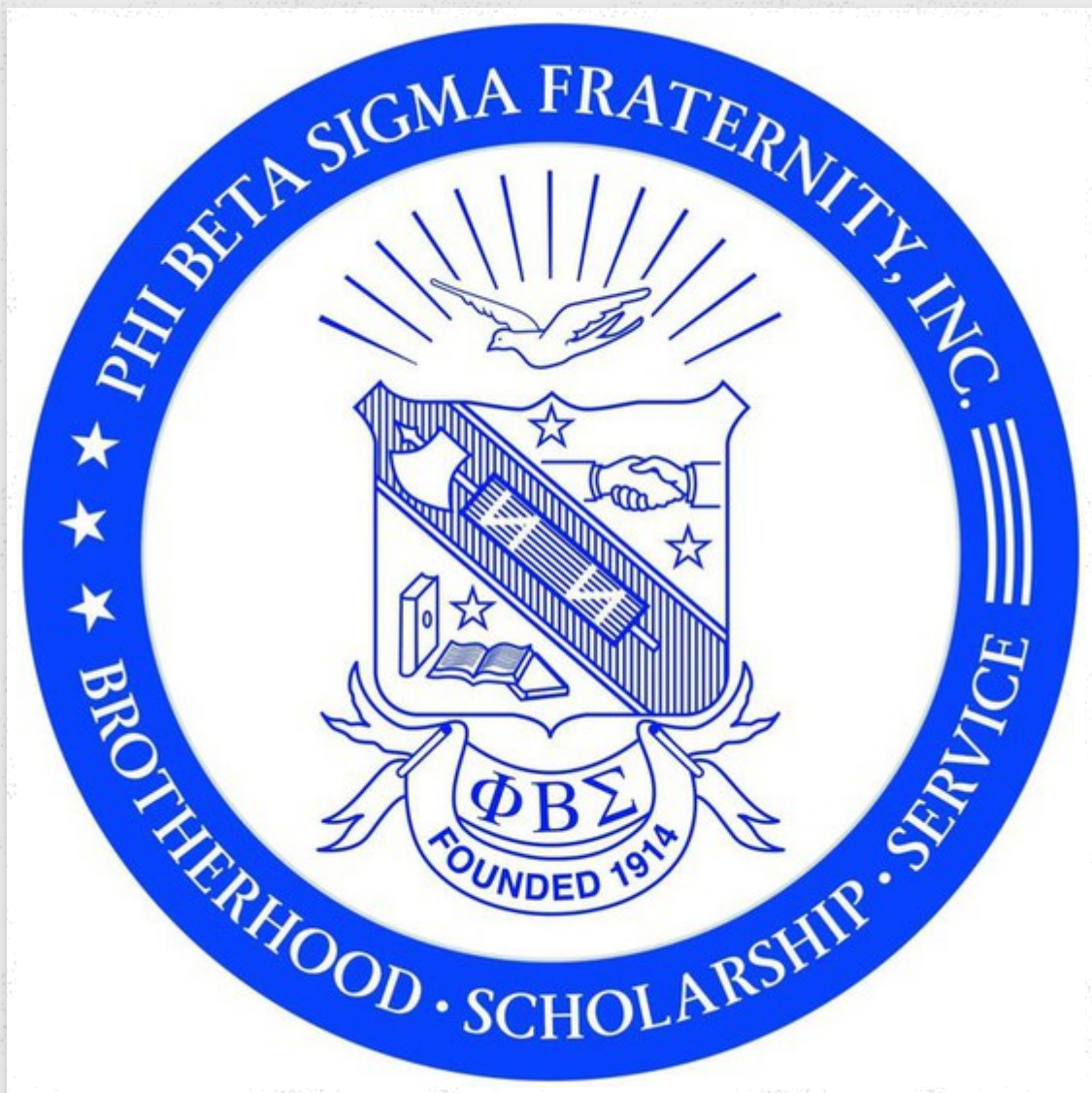


