NURSE'S CORNER

REMINDER REGARDING THE ADMINISTRATION

OF MEDICATIONS DURING THE SCHOOL DAY

**No Prescription medications may be administered without proper authorization from a healthcare provider. Medical Authorization Forms are available in paper form from the nurse or online at www.bcsdk12.net under Departments => Students Affairs => School Nursing Services.

** Over the counter medications such as Motrin (Ibuprofen), Tylenol (Acetaminophen), Acid Reflux medication (Tums, Maalox) and Benadryl (for Allergic emergency Only) may be given with authorization. This Authorization is given through parent portal by clicking yes on the medications you want your child to be able to receive, when you do your Annual Update. Depending upon the medical problem, the authorization may be in place for the entire school year. Each school year a new medication authorization form needs to be filled out and signed for Prescription Medications.

**Students may not self-medicate.

** All medications should be brought to the school by a responsible adult. Students may not bring or carry any type of medications on them, in napkins or in their backpack.

*This policy is to prevent lost medications, accidental ingestion by another student or an overdose by your child. Most pharmacies will provide an additional container for antibiotics and other medications if requested.

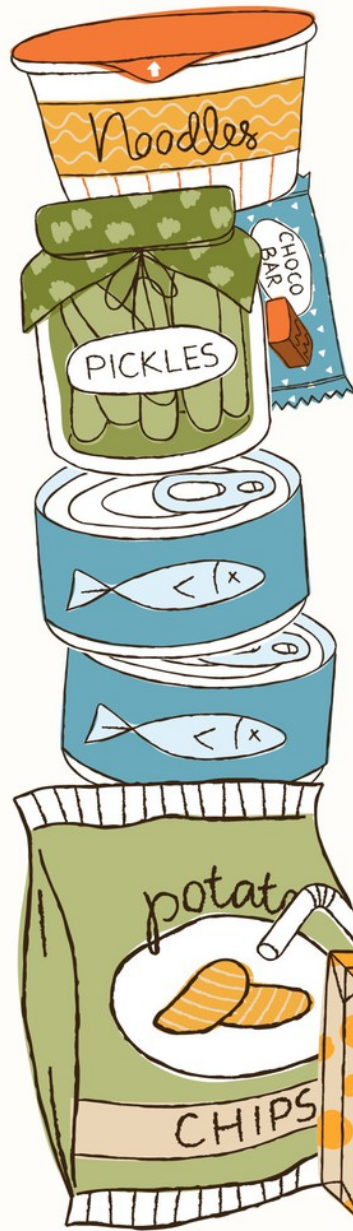


CONTEST GUIDELINES:

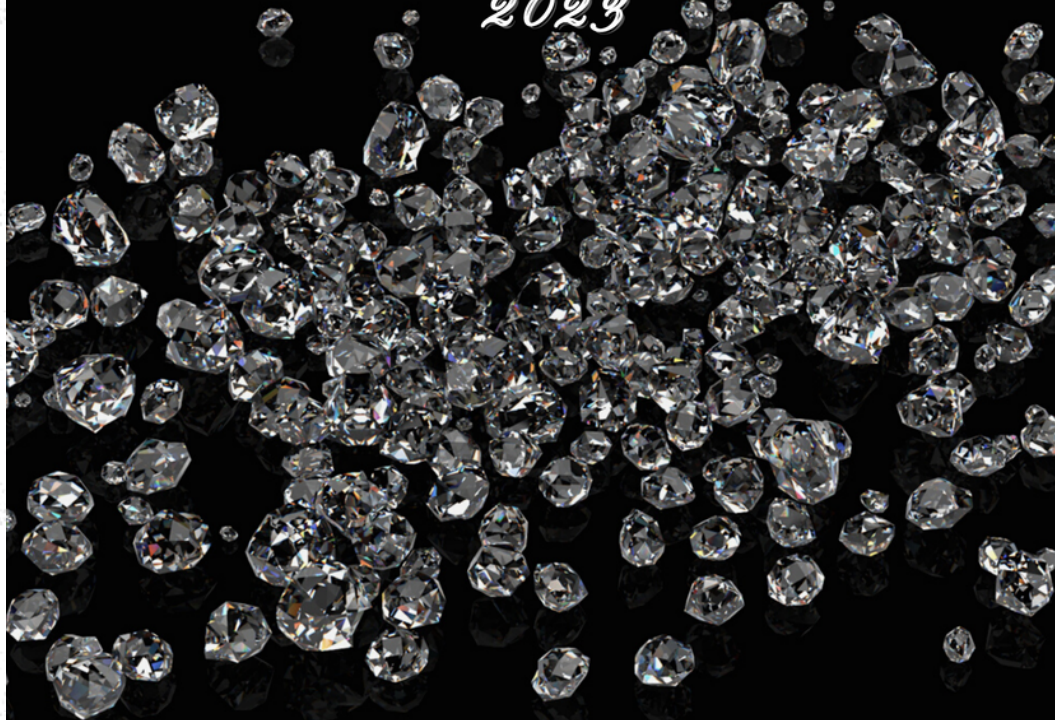

Rise to Success program requirements include:

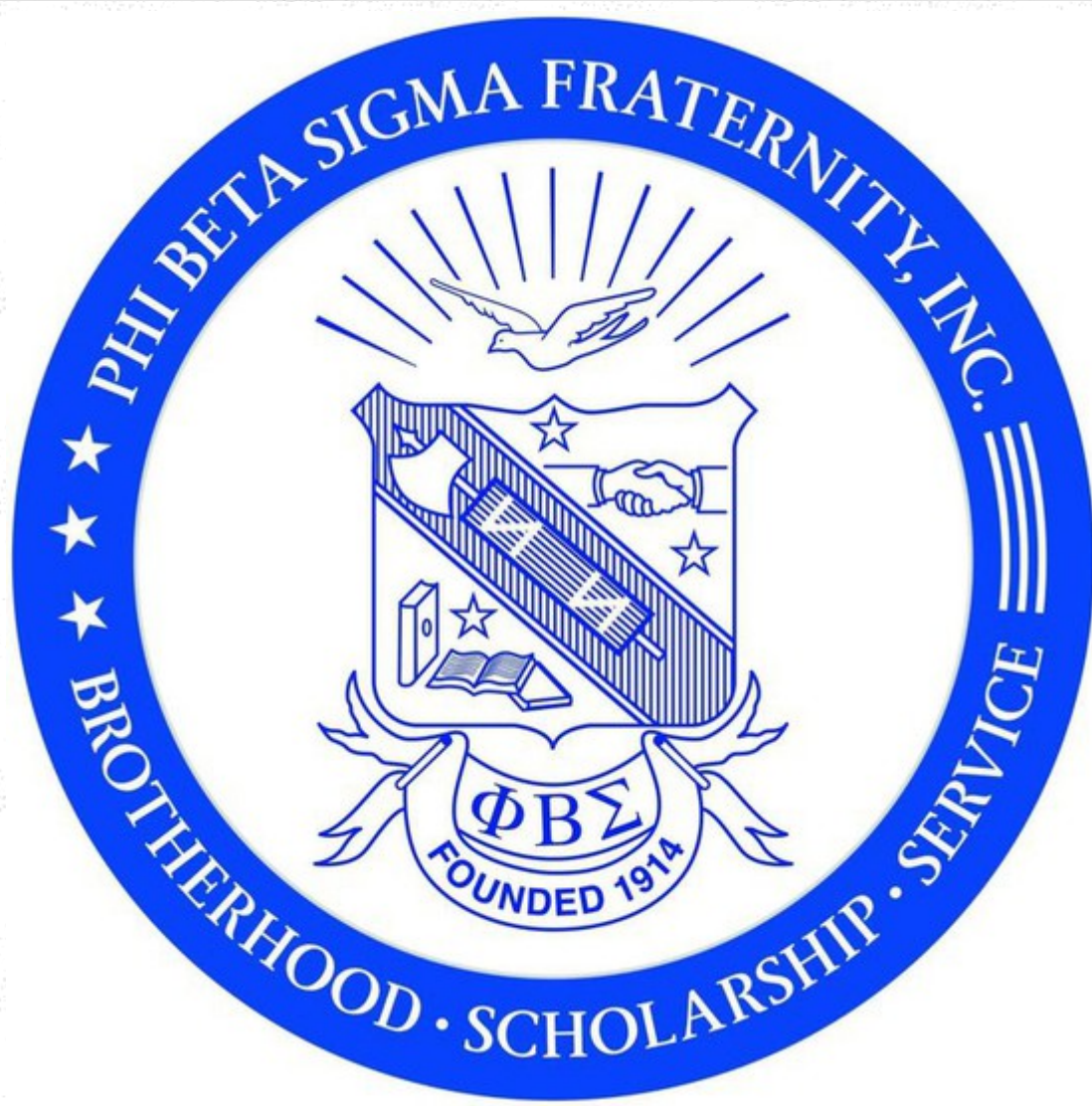
