




## THE HOWARD HIGH SCHOOL ACCESS DEPARTMENT HOSTED A SERVICES FAIR





- » Check with your high school counselor to make sure you are on track to complete the required number of NCAA-approved <u>core</u> <u>courses</u> and graduate on time with your class.
- » Take the <u>SAT/ACT</u> and submit your scores to the Eligibility Center using code 9999.\*
- » At the end of the school year, ask your high school counselor from each school you have attended to upload an official transcript to your Eligibility Center account.

### **SENIOR YEAR: GRADUATE**

- » Complete your final NCAA-approved core courses as you prepare for graduation.
- » After you graduate, ask your high school counselor to upload your final <u>official transcript</u> with proof of graduation to your Eligibility Center account.

The Georgia Foundation for Agriculture is committed to investing in students pursuing careers in agriculture or a related field. For the 2023 year, GFA is offering \$70,000 worth of scholarships. There are several scholarship opportunities available to students, each with varying criteria and eligibility requirements.

The four scholarship categories are:

- Scholarship for Agriculture—10 Scholarships of \$3,000. Like last year, the top 3 ranking applicants will be eligible for an additional \$1,000 bonus.






