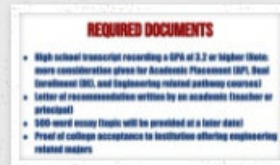
U.S. Presidential Scholars Program

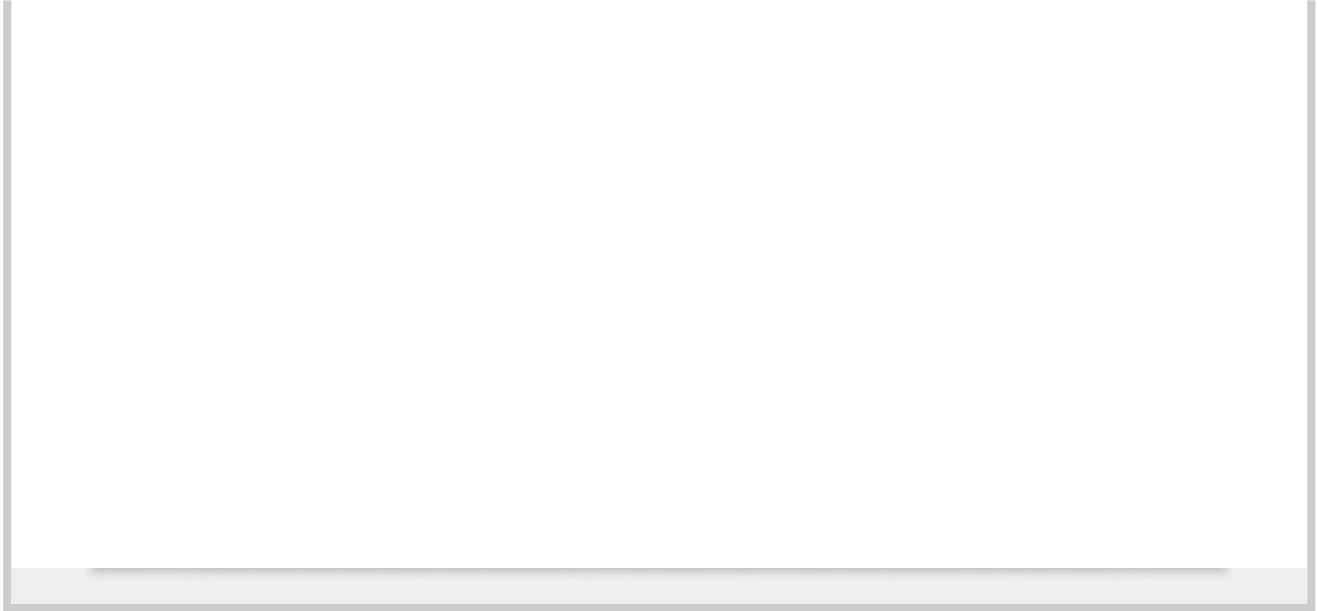
