

### **PSAT information for Juniors:**

We will be giving the PSAT on Tuesday, October 25. Even though your student may have tested as a sophomore last year, to compete for the National Merit Scholarships students must take it their Junior Year. It is also strongly encouraged for any college-bound students to take this opportunity to improve their test-taking skills ahead of the SAT/ACT.

Juniors may take the test again; the cost is \$18. If your student would like to take the PSAT on October 25, please pay our bookkeeper, Ms. Curry, \$18 by 3:00 pm, Tuesday, October 18-you may pay using cash, check, or charge and call her at 779-7859 to pay over the phone. The next Saturday SAT is November 5th, 2022.

<u>Reminder</u>: For admission to the Test Center, you must have a Valid Picture ID and a printed copy of your Admissions Ticket. Please reference the College Board website for a detailed list of approved forms of ID and how to print your admissions ticket prior to testing. If you have any questions please see the Howard High School Saturday SAT Test Center Supervisor, Mrs. Giles.

# **ID Checklist**

ID documents must meet all of these requirements:

- Be a valid (unexpired) photo ID that is government issued or issued by the school that you currently attend. School IDs from the prior school year are valid through the end of December of the current calendar year. (For example, school IDs from 2020-21 can be used through December 31, 2021.)
- · Be an original, physical document (not photocopied or electronic).
- Bear your full, legal name exactly as it appears on your Admission Ticket, including the order of the names
- Bear a recent recognizable photograph that clearly matches both your appearance on test day and the photo you provided when you registered.
- Be in good condition, with clearly legible English language text and a clearly visible photograph.

# Acceptable ID Examples

- · Government issued driver's license or non-driver ID card
- · Official school-produced student ID card from the school you currently attend
- · Government issued passport or U.S. Global Entry identification card
- · Government issued military or national identification card
- SAT Student ID Form: must be prepared by the school you currently attend or a notary, if homeschooled
