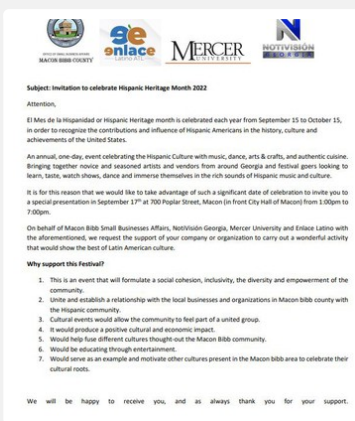

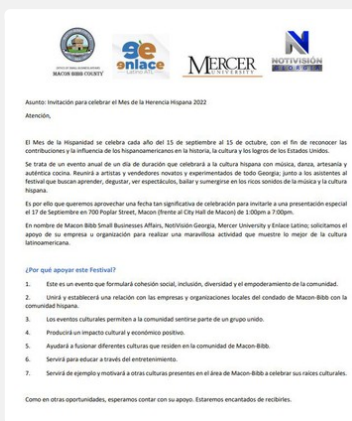

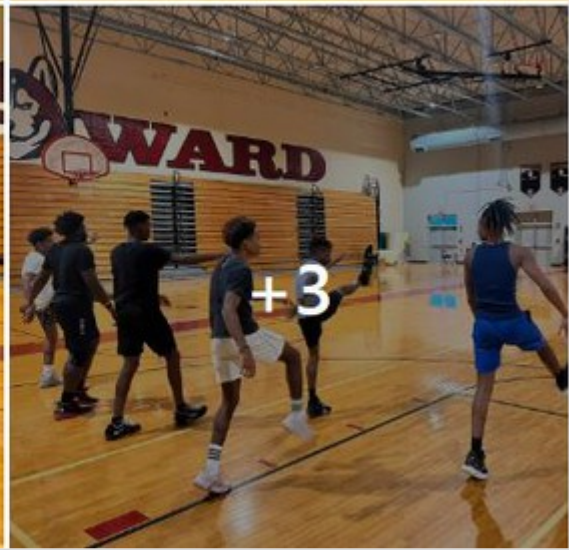

LAPTOP CARE

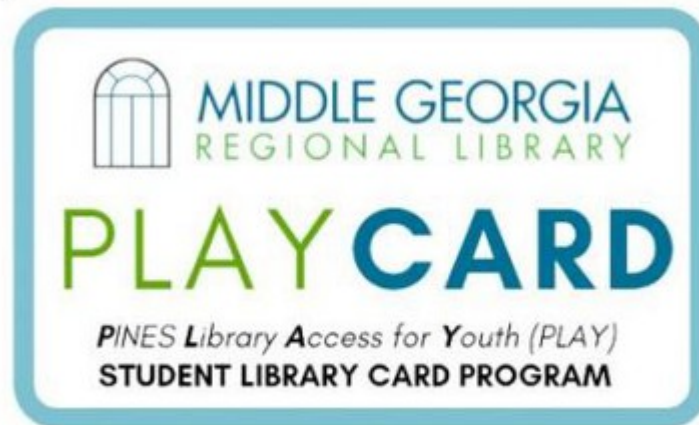
- Always keep your laptop closed when you need to walk with your laptop and it's not in the carrying case.

- Keep drinks and liquids away from your computer. A spill can damage the hard drive and the motherboard. Such damages could cause you to pay the total cost to replace the laptop, up to \$300 or more. Please be careful!

Research Tip

If you are working on a research project make sure that the sources you use are valid and not fake! Check other sources such as GALILEO and Google Scholar to determine if you can locate the same story to ensure it is not Fake News. 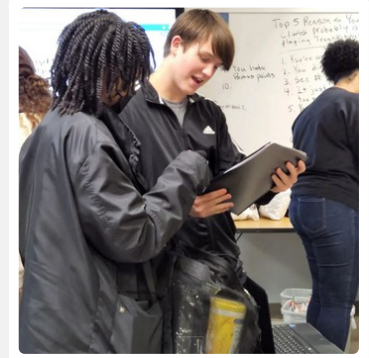

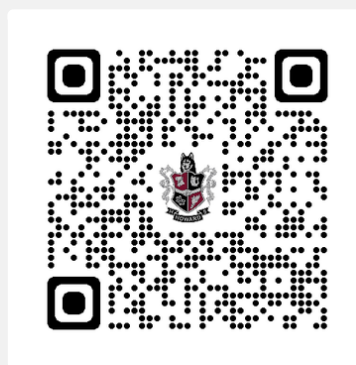
