



COVID-19 Vaccinations & Boosters Available

The Georgia Department of Public Health / CORE will offer COVID-19 vaccinations and boosters **February 16, March 9 and March 30, from 3-6 p.m.** CORE will only be vaccinating individuals 12 years and older at these events. Pfizer and Moderna vaccines and boosters will be available. These events are open to the public. Supplies are available first come, first served. **Howard High School 6400 Forsyth Road The event is open to the public.**

PLEASE NOTE: Please make sure to review the CDC's revised guidelines regarding vaccination / booster status as it relates to isolation and quarantine requirements.

While the vaccine has been approved for those ages 5 and older, CORE will only be vaccinating individuals 12 years and older at these events. Pfizer and Moderna vaccines and boosters will be available. Supplies are available first come, first served.




The Georgia District Civitan Foundation Scholarship Opportunities





3-2-1 Reading Strategy

The 3-2-1 prompts helps students structure their responses to a text, film, or lesson. Student may be asked for three takeaways, two questions, and one thing they enjoyed. provides an easy way for teachers to check for understanding and to gauge students' interest in a topic. It is also an effective way to prompt a class discussion or to review material from a previous lesson. Responses may be used to guide instruction. 3-2-1 responses can help the teacher identify areas of instruction that may need to be reviewed or concepts or activities that hold special interest for students. The prompts can be modified to content questions or main ideas. Students may be given the following prompts: (facinghistory.org)

Three things they learned from the text.Two questions they still have.One aspect of the text they enjoyed.

Three of the most important ideas from the text.Two supporting details for each of the ideas.One question they have about each of the ideas.






Rotary International Speech Contest
