Credit Repair Courses **MUST** be complete by Monday, January 31

First semester grades posted to the portal for students and parents to see on Friday, January 7, 2022.

Students will receive credit towards graduation for courses where the grade earned was a 70 or higher.

Students who earned a failing grade of 64-69 in a first semester core course (English, Math, Science, or Social Studies) or Spanish qualify for Credit Repair.

Credit Repair is earned by successfully completing a repair course on the computer via Edgenuity. When the Edgenuity credit repair course is completed (at 100%) with a passing grade (70+), the previously earned failing classroom grade of 64-69 will be amended to a 70, and credit towards graduation will be awarded on the student's transcript.

Credit Repair courses will be loaded onto Edgenuity by the end of the day on Wednesday, January 12, 2022 (courses may be loaded earlier - it would be in your student's best interest to check each day to see if the course(s) has/have been loaded).

Credit Repair Courses MUST be complete by Monday, January 31, 2022 at 2:35 PM. Courses will close at that time, and there will be no extension - regardless of reason. Not completing a credit repair will result in the student having to retake the entire course in summer school; it may also mean that a student will not promote to the next grade level at the end of the school year, as promotion in high school is based entirely on credits earned.

IF YOU ARE AN ATHLETE, TALK TO YOUR COACH ABOUT WHEN YOUR CREDIT REPAIR IS DUE TO ENSURE ELIGIBILITY TO PLAY THIS SEMESTER, as that date may be prior to the January 31st deadline.

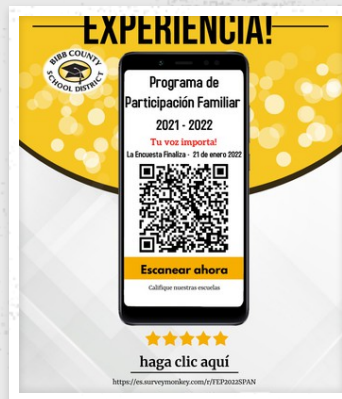

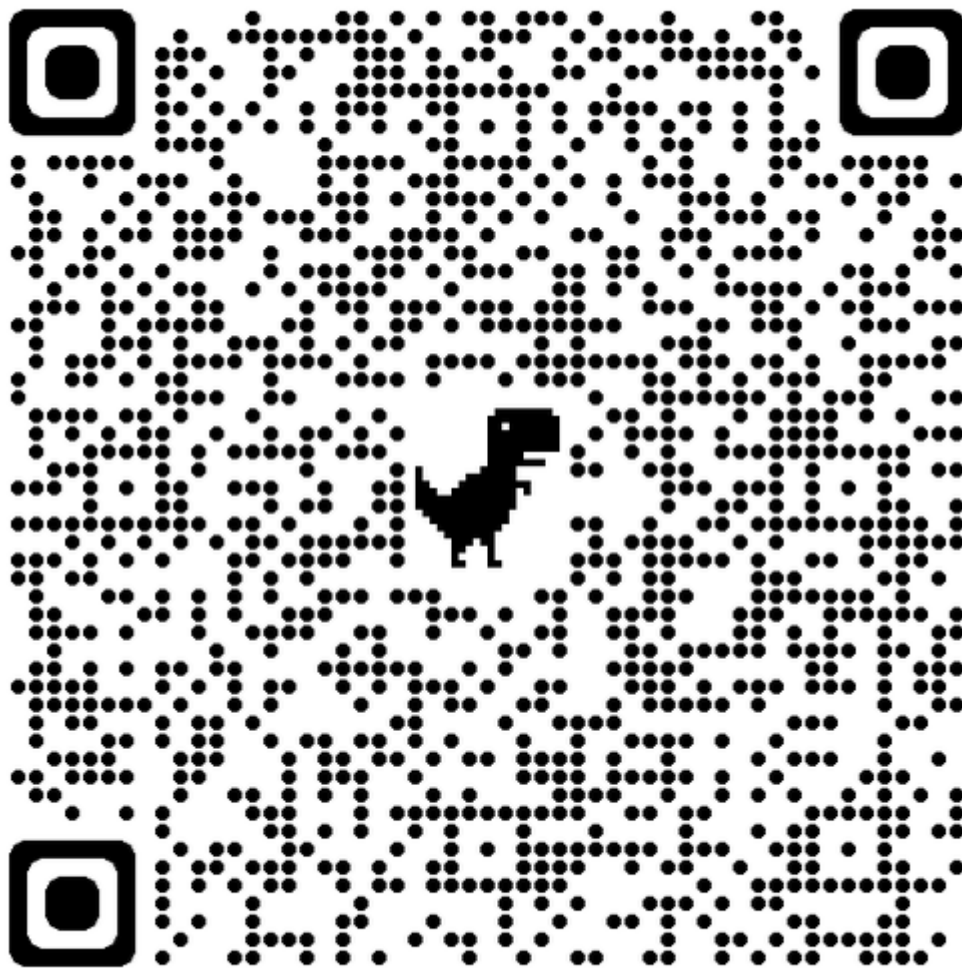

The Georgia Foundation for Agriculture is committed to investing in students pursuing careers in agriculture or a related field. For 2022, the foundation is offering scholarships for graduating high school seniors, rising college juniors and seniors, technical college students and UGA College of Veterinary Medicine students specializing in large/food animals.

The four scholarship categories the Georgia Foundation for Agriculture is offering are:

Scholarship for Agriculture

Ten scholarships of \$3,000 are available. For the first time, the top three ranking applicants will be eligible for an additional \$1,000 bonus. **Applicants must:**

- Be a Georgia resident
- Be a graduating high school senior
- During the 2022-23 academic year, enroll in a unit of The University System of Georgia, Berry College, Emmanuel College or any accredited college/university in Georgia with an ag program.
- Pursue an undergraduate degree in agricultural & environmental sciences, family & consumer sciences or a related ag field.
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA

Technical College Scholarship for Agriculture

Rising College Jr./Sr. Scholarship for Agriculture

- Be a sophomore or junior with at least two semesters remaining to receive undergraduate degree at a unit of The University System of Georgia, Berry College, Emmanuel College or any accredited college/university in Georgia with an ag program
- Be engaged in college leadership activities
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA

UGA College of Veterinary Medicine Scholarship

Two scholarships of \$5,000 are available. **Applicants must:**

- Be a Georgia resident
- Be a current University of Georgia veterinary medicine student specializing in large animal/food animal practice
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA

AWESOME Summaries

Summarizing requires students to process and synthesize information. Many students do not know how to write a summary. This strategy is designed to give students a simple acronym that will assist with writing a high-quality summary. The acronym defines the elements of an effective summary. AWESOME may be used before writing to plan the summary; it may be used during writing as guidelines for creating the summary; and it may be used after writing the summary to review the work. (Silver, J and McTighe, H. Teaching for Deeper Learning: Tools to Engage Students in Meaning Making, 2020)

A - Is the information in my summary accurate?

W - Has the length of the original material been reduced significantly?

E - Did I include enough information to capture the essence of the original material?

S - Is the information in my summary logically organized and sequenced?

O - Did I give an objective (free of opinions) summary of the original material?

M - Did I summarize the original material in my own words?

E - Does my summary contain the essential ideas only? Did I eliminate unnecessary details?

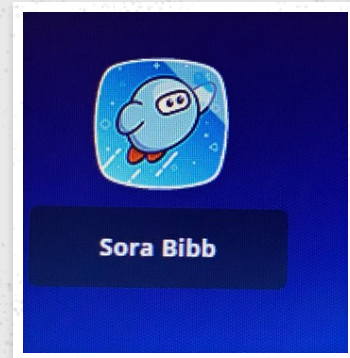

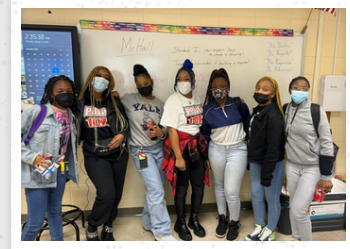
