Lafayette Jeff on Saturday welcomes schools for 14th annual Xtreme Choir Showdown

LAFAYETTE, Ind. - Lafayette Jefferson High School will host the 14th annual Xtreme Show Choir Showdown Saturday, March 2, featuring 25 choirs from 16 different middle and high schools in Indiana and Illinois.

Choirs from Ben Davis, Carmel, North Central, Naperville North and Wheaton Warrenville South are among those set to perform. As host, Lafayette Jeff's First Edition, A Cappella and Expressions choirs will not compete but will perform exhibitions.

"The Xtreme Show Choir Showdown at Lafayette Jefferson High School has become an event known throughout Indiana and the Midwest for the quality of the choirs and the impressive lineup of participating schools," said Jeff Choral Director Mark Myers.

This weekend's competition runs from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. in the Rohrman Performing Arts Center, home to the state-of-the-art, 1,200-seat Richard Jaeger Theatre.

Tickets are \$15 for an adult all-day pass (cash price, \$16 cards). For children ages 3-12, cost is \$5 (cash price, \$6 cards).

"This competition has grown in popularity over the past several years. Having schools with such impressive programs, schools like Ben Davis, Carmel, Naperville North and Wheaton Warrenville South really raises the bar of competition," Myers said.

Small Mixed Choirs compete from 8-10:55 a.m., followed by Small Treble Choirs, 11:50 a.m.-1:05 p.m.; Jr. High/Middle School, 1:30-2:30 p.m.; Large Treble Groups, 3:30-6:30 p.m.; and Large Mixed Groups, 7-10 p.m.

Winners in each category will be announced during a formal ceremony at 10 p.m. in the Richard Jaeger Theatre.
