Provided however, that if any such claim, action, action, or suit may be brought only in a federal forum, it shall be brought and conducted solely and exclusively within the United States District Court for the District of Oregon.
9.	Indemnity – shall defend, save, hold harmless, and indemnify the Medford School District, their officers, employees, agents and members, from all claims, suits, or actions of whatsoever nature resulting from or arising out of the activities of or its officers, employees, subcontractors, or agents under this agreement.
10.	Insurance – shall provide insurance as indicated on Exhibit A, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
11.	Ownership of Work Product – All work products of that result from this agreement ("the work products") are the exclusive property of the District. In addition, if any of the work products contain intellectual property of that is or could be protected by federal copyright, patent, or trademark laws, hereby grants the District a perpetual, royalty-free fully paid-up, nonexclusive and irrevocable license to copy, reproduce, deliver, publish, perform, dispose of, use and re-use, in whole or in part, and to authorize others to do so, all such work products, including but not limited to databases, templates, materials, training manuals and other training materials and any other information, designs, plans, or works provided or delivered to the District or produced by under this agreement.
12.	Force Majeure – Neither the District nor shall be held responsible for delay or default caused by fire, riot, acts of God, or war where such cause was beyond, respectively, the District's or ' reasonable control shall, however, make all reasonable efforts to remove or eliminate such a cause of delay or default and shall, upon the cessation of the cause, diligently pursue performance of its obligations under this agreement.
13.	Severability – The parties agree that if any term or provision of this agreement is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal or in conflict with any law, the validity of the remaining terms and provisions shall not be affected, and the rights and obligations of the parties shall be construed and enforced as if the agreement did not contain the

particular term or provision held to be invalid.

- **14. Waiver** The failure of the District to enforce any provision of this agreement shall not constitute a waiver by the District of that or any other provision.
- **15. Execution and Counterparts** This agreement may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be an original, all of which shall constitute but one and the same instrument.
- 16. Use of Chemicals With respect to chemicals used during the course of the Work, will implement and enforce a program to inventory and properly store and secure all chemicals that may be used or present at the District site, maintain available for inspection all material data safety sheets, and comply with all regulations required by law for the storage, use, and disposal of chemicals. This program will incorporate and include the District's Hazard Communication Program and be subject to approval of and modification by the District. The program must provide for notification of all personnel of potential chemical hazards. Review of these hazards must be included in safety training program. shall submit to the District a list of all Hazardous or its Subcontractors onto the Materials to be brought by District's property, including the purpose for their use on the Project. 17.
