

Students earn an associate's degree or 60 college credit hours free of cost. Odessa Collegiate Academy high school core classes are Pre AP. OCA is a high school of choice for ECISD students, freshman through seniors.

Admission Criteria

Current 8th grade students apply by submitting a completed application.
Students must be on track to completing the 8th grade. Students are selected using criteria from the Texas Education Agency (TEA). Enrollment is limited.

ABOUT OCA

- OUR ENROLLMENT IS CURRENTLY AT 330 STUDENTS, GRADES 9-12, WITH 106 FRESHMEN STUDENTS.
- WE HAVE 17 CERTIFIED TEACHERS, 2 OFFICE STAFF MEMBERS, 1 SCHOOL NURSE, 1 HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR, 1 DUAL CREDIT LIAISON FROM OC, ONE DEAN FROM OC, AND 1 PRINCIPAL
- STUDENTS ALSO TAKE CLASSES WITH ABOUT 20 COLLEGE PROFESSORS THROUGHOUT THEIR 4 YEARS AT OCA
- THERE IS A FULL TIME OC POLICE DEPARTMENT THAT MONITORS ODESSA COLLEGE, OCA, AND OCTECHS 24 HOURS A DAY 7 OFFICERS
- WE ACCEPT ABOUT 115 FRESHMEN EACH YEAR. SCHOOL CAPACITY IS ABOUT 400 STUDENTS, WHICH IS ABOUT 100 STUDENTS PER GRADE LEVEL.



ECISD SCHOOL BOARD POLICY

EIA Regulation – Academic Achievement Grading: "A minimum of 9 grades per nine weeks grading period shall be recorded in grade books used in computing grades."

Most OCA teachers record many more grades than the district minimum every nine weeks. It is important for parents to monitor their child's grades weekly.

Parents are strongly encouraged to sign up for Parent Portal to review their child's grades online. Please see our Campus Secretary to receive your pass code to sign up for Parent Portal.

SEMESTER AVERAGES

For any specific semester, the 2 nine-weeks averages will count 37.5% each and the final examination will count 25% of the semester grade.

Example:

1st 9 Weeks Average 96 x .375 = 36.00 2nd 9 Weeks Average 86 x .375 = 32.25

Final Exam Grade 95 x .250 = 23.75

= 92.00

= 92 Semester Average

REGULAR CLASSES

Each nine weeks grading period, teachers will record a minimum of 9 instructional grades and 3 planner grades. Instructional grades will be divided into Major and Minor categories.

(tests, essays, projects, presentations, major labs, etc...) Teachers must have a minimum of 3 grades in this category every nine weeks.

Maior Grades ...

Minor Grades 45%

(quizzes, labs, homework, daily work, student participation, journals, notebook checks, etc...) Teachers must have a minimum of 6 grades in this category every nine weeks.

Student Planner Grades 59

Teachers will take 3 planner grades every nine weeks period.

Late Work - 11 pts. per School Day

Re-Do Failed Assignments Students can re-do an attempted failed assignment for a maximum grade of 75 on the 2nd attempt

Teachers have the authority in deciding which instructional assignments are Major grades or Minor grades. Teachers may also choose to offer an instructional assignment as extra credit, or offer test corrections, but are not required to do so.



(Pre-AP & GT)

Each nine weeks grading period, teachers will record a minimum of 9 instructional grades and 3 planner grades. Instructional grades will be divided into Major and Minor categories.

Maior Grades 60%

(tests, essays, projects, presentations, major labs, etc...) Teachers must have a minimum of 3 grades in this category every nine weeks.

Minor Grades 35%

(quizzes, labs, homework, daily work, student participation, journals, notebook checks, etc...) Teachers must have a minimum of 6 grades in this category every nine weeks.

Student Planner Grades 5%

Teachers will take 3 planner grades every nine weeks period.

Late Work - 11 pts. per School Day

Re-Do Failed Assignments Students can re-do an attempted failed assignment for a maximum grade of 75 on the 2nd attempt

Teachers have the authority in deciding which instructional assignments are Major grades or Minor grades. Teachers may also choose to offer an instructional assignment as extra credit, or offer test corrections, but are not required to do so.



GRADES & TUTORING

- STUDENTS HAVE A 30 MINUTE ADVISORY EVERY DAY BEFORE OR AFTER LUNCH WHERE THEY CAN WORK ON HOMEWORK
- STUDENTS HAVE AN 80 MINUTE DUAL CREDIT LAB PERIOD FOR THEIR COLLEGE CLASSES
- TUTORING IS OFFERED EVERY DAY, INCLUDING A BLOCK OF TIME ON FRIDAY FROM 2:30 4:00 PM
- STUDENTS WHO FAIL A CLASS AT THE 9 WEEKS GRADING PERIOD ARE PLACED ON ACADEMIC PROBATION
- STUDENTS WHO FAIL CLASSES AT SEMESTER ARE REMOVED FROM THE PROGRAM

ATTENDANCE

ATTENDANCE IS VERY IMPORTANT AT OCA

- MISSING TWO DAYS EQUALS TO MISSING A WEEK'S WORTH OF SCHOOL ASSIGNMENTS
- PARENTS MUST CALL IN THEIR CHILD IF THEY ARE SICK
- STUDENTS ARE PLACED ON ATTENDANCE CONTRACTS IF THEY HAVE 5 OR MORE ABSENCES
- STUDENTS LOSE CREDIT FROM THE CLASS (FAIL) WITH 9 OR MORE ABSENCES
- STUDENTS CAN BE DISMISSED FROM THE PROGRAM AFTER 9 ABSENCES




REQUIRED SUMMER BRIDGE PROGRAM



ATHLETICS & FINE ARTS AT PERMIAN AND OHS




