#### **PROM REMINDERS**

Prom is April 13th from 7:00 pm to 11:00 pm at Martin's Crosswinds in Greenbelt, Maryland.

- All attendees must present their ticket upon arrival at the venue.
- All approved outside guests must present photo identification AND a ticket AND arrive with the NPHS junior or senior who purchased the ticket.
- Parents/guardians/family/friends may not enter the prom venue to take photographs.
- Prom attendees may not leave the venue and return. Once an attendee exits the building, he/she will not be permitted to reenter the prom.
- Food will be served from 7-9 pm. The prom menu includes: orange glazed chicken, herb salmon, meatballs, lasagna, chicken & waffle station, garlic mashed potatoes and rice pilaf. There will be slushies, soft drinks, a chocolate fountain, and a dessert table.
- Students must arrive no later than 10 pm. After 10 pm, guests will not be allowed to enter the prom.
- Prom will end promptly at 11:00 pm All rides (parents/limos) must be at the venue promptly by 11:00 pm.

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## JROTC CADET LEADERSHIP COURSE - SUMMER 2024

North Point High School JROTC will hold their annual JROTC Cadet Leadership Course (CLC) from 24-28 June 2024. CLC is an introductory JROTC program designed to give students a sampling of JROTC activities and a jump-start on the school year. The program is open to all incoming high school students, but is highly recommended for students who are considering taking JROTC in the coming school year.

A typical day will include light physical fitness, drill and ceremony, and classroom instruction on topics such as leadership fundamentals, goal setting, time management, and being a successful student. Field trips are also a big part of the program and will be scheduled throughout the week.

The training will start each morning at 7:30 am and end at 4:00 pm. Optional gym time or group activity time will be available 4:00 to 6:00 pm. Instructors will be on-site for drop-off as early as 6:00 am each morning. The cost for CLC is \$150.00 per cadet. This fee covers lunch and a snack each day, CLC uniform items, and field trip transportation.

Transportation to and from NPHS is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Space is limited, so get your spot reserved as soon as possible, no later than June 3. Contact Lt. Col.
