2024 JUNIOR/ SENIOR PROM INFORMATION

Prom is April 13th from 7:00 pm to 11:00 pm at Martin's Crosswinds in Greenbelt, Maryland. Tickets will be on sale during lunches April 2nd - 5th.

Prom tickets cost \$100. Cash, check, or money order made out to North Point High School will be accepted. No credit card sales.

Dinner will be served at prom - see menu below.

School debts must be paid (including senior dues and laptop damage fees) before purchasing a ticket. Email Dgarcia@ccboe.com if you have questions or concerns about student debt.

- Juniors and seniors may only purchase a maximum of two tickets (for self and up to 1 guest)
- A completed prom guest form must be turned in for a guest that does not attend NPHS.
- Guest forms can be picked up in the main office at NPHS. Your guest must get the VP at their school to sign the form. Turn completed guest forms into the NPHS main office by March 19.
- Only juniors and seniors may purchase tickets to the prom.
- All attendees must present their ticket upon arrival at the venue.
- All approved outside guests must present photo identification AND a ticket AND arrive with the NPHS junior or senior who purchased the ticket.
- Prom attendees may not leave the venue and return. Once an attendee exits the building, he/she will not be permitted to reenter the prom.
- Parents/guardians/family/friends may not enter the prom venue to take photographs.
- Prom will end promptly at 11:00 pm All rides (parents/limos) must be at the venue promptly by 11:00 pm.
- Appropriate formal attire must be worn. Parents and students may read the approved CCPS formal wear dress code on page 12-13 at <u>CodeofConduct20212022.pdf (finalsite.net)</u>
- Prom is an official CCPS event. Students and their guests are expected to follow all rules and expectations as outlined in the in the CCPS Code of Conduct.
- The prom venue employs security and will have police officers on site.
- Food will be served from 7-9 pm. The prom menu includes: orange glazed chicken, herb salmon, meatballs, lasagna, chicken & waffle station, garlic mashed potatoes and rice pilaf. There will be unlimited slushies, a chocolate fountain, and a dessert table.
- Students must arrive no later than 10 pm. After 10 pm, guests will not be allowed to enter the prom.

JROTC CADET LEADERSHIP COURSE - SUMMER 2024

North Point High School JROTC will hold their annual JROTC Cadet Leadership Course (CLC) from 24-28 June 2024. CLC is an introductory JROTC program designed to give students a sampling of JROTC activities and a jump-start on the school year. The program is open to all incoming high school students, but is highly recommended for students who are considering taking JROTC in the coming school year.

A typical day will include light physical fitness, drill and ceremony, and classroom instruction on topics such as leadership fundamentals, goal setting, time management, and being a successful student. Field trips are also a big part of the program and will be scheduled throughout the week.

The training will start each morning at 7:30 am and end at 4:00 pm. Optional gym time or group activity time will be available 4:00 to 6:00 pm. Instructors will be on-site for drop-off as early as 6:00 am each morning. The cost for CLC is \$150.00 per cadet. This fee covers lunch and a snack each day, CLC uniform items, and field trip transportation.

Transportation to and from NPHS is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Space is limited, so get your spot reserved as soon as possible, no later than June 3. Contact Lt. Col.
