Click-wrap agreements are online contracts that users agree to by clicking a button or checking a box that says that they agree to the terms of service and policies that govern users of the particular site.

These agreements are often not thoroughly read by the user and they serve as legally binding contracts.

When a district employee accepts these terms for products or services that they are using at school, the employee enters into a contract on behalf of their employer.

This can lead to agreeing to terms of use of student data that are not Ed Law 2-d compliant.
