

# Tickets

- The last day to purchase a ticket will be April 20<sup>th</sup>
- Only seniors may purchase tickets
- Tickets will not be sold at the door
- There are no refunds on tickets
- Must not be currently serving a discipline consequence of JJAEP, DAEP-ALA, or OSS
- **Prom tickets will be distributed on campus on April 23rd, April 24th, April 25th, and 26th, 2024, during lunch.**
- You cannot swap, sell, or substitute your tickets. Prom tickets must be used by the people who are named at the time of purchase.

# Prom Guests

- Must be a high school student or must be under 21 years old on the day of prom
- You are limited to one guest.
- Non-Turner students need to fill out the Prom Guest Form (**GREEN FORM**) and a photocopy of their driver's license or State ID card or picture ID is needed for you to purchase a ticket.

- Tuesdays and Thursdays during Mega Lunch and from 2:45 p.m.-7:30 p.m.
- Prom Dresses, Shoes, and Accessories—first come, first served at no cost and you can keep them.
- Men's attire is available.

# Other Info for Prom Night

- Must follow the Pearland ISD Student Code of Conduct.
- There is no Bag/Coat Check.
- All entering **must** present their ID at check-in.
- Everyone must have their ID upon entry.
- You DO NOT need your prom ticket (it's a keepsake).

# FAFSA INFORMATION



- In accordance with Texas Education Code (TEC), §28.0256, graduating seniors enrolled during the 2023-2024 school year, must do one of the following in order to graduate:
- \*Complete and submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- \*Complete and submit a Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA)
- A student may graduate under the Foundation High School Program without completing a financial aid application by completing the FAFSA Opt-Out form (see your counselor)
