Problem Statement 1 Associate degrees	Based on our current Starfish report, 12% of PSJA Thomas Jefferson TSTEM ECHS seniors are in danger of failing a dual credit course, leading to incomplete Associate or Certificate degrees.
Goal Area 1 Associate degrees	By May 2024, PSJA Thomas Jefferson TSTEM ECHS will maintain the projected number of students who earn an Associate’s degree.
Problem Statement 2 Industry Based Certifications	Based on data, not enough students are completing the Health Science Endorsement and Industry Based Certification in EKG, Phlebotomy, CAN, and EMT.
Goal Area 2 Industry Based Certifications	By July 2024, PSJA Thomas Jefferson TSTEM ECHS will reconstruct the Health Science sequence in the master schedule in order to increase the number of certificates by 10% for the class of 2025.
Problem Statement 3 Advanced Placement Scores	Based on data, the percentage of students passing an AP exam needs to increase compared to the number of students participating.
Goal Area 3 Advanced Placement Scores	By July 2024, PSJA Thomas Jefferson TSTEM ECHS will increase AP 3+ scores by 5%.
Problem Statement 4 Financial Aid (FASFA)	The percent of tier 3 students (seniors that took English 3 AP) receiving a scholarship is at 43% compared to 60% for all students.
Goal Area 4 Financial Aid (FASFA)	By June 2024, PSJA Thomas Jefferson TSTEM ECHS Financial Aid office will increase the percent of tier 3 students receiving a scholarship award by 7%.
