•The learning environment should be stimulating, positive, **supportive** and safe.







I/GCSE Results 2023

- 100% pass rate
- 41% of results graded 9-8 (A** to A*)
- 56% of results graded 9-7 (A** to A)
- 96% of results graded 4 or above (C+)
- 98% of students achieved 5 grades 9-4 (A** to C)
- 62% of results were either on or above the higher aspirational target grade








Year 6 transition timeline

KS3 Core Curriculum



A 3 year programme based on the UK National curriculum for students aged 11-14



Key Stage 3 Assessment



Students will be assessed using 4 criteria to measure academic performance against expected standards in each subject for that year group:

- X Excelling in comparison to the expected standard
 - E -Exceeding the expected standard
 - A Working at the expected standard
 - T- Working towards the expected standard

The same end of year examination will be set for all students so that teachers are accurately able to assess the progress of all students across the year group. Additional time is allowed for identified students.



Reporting to Parents

Opportunities to meet the teachers

• **PTSC** afternoon and evening dates are communicated to parents at the start of the academic year. You are invited to book appointments to discuss progress with subject teachers in October and February.

Two reports are issued

- Interim report in December.
- Full report in June.

There is a Y7 examination week in the summer term

• Exam results will be issued to students.
