## About Our Program

**Our Staff:** The Director, Sandra Condon, has experience as a childcare provider, Clarkstown teacher, and mother. The preschool 4 classrooms are staffed with certified teachers and highly qualified childcare assistants. All of our teachers have a strong background in early education and in some cases, our assistants are also trained teachers. Our candidates were selected from a very motivated and enthusiastic group of people who all recognize the importance of this endeavor. We are proud to be able to put together such a dynamic childcare team.

### Our Programs:

**Infants:** Caregivers will ensure that the children feel loved, secure, and happy. This will be achieved through one-to-one interaction with adults speaking in a pleasant, soothing voice. Eye contact and simple language will engage each child in social development. Infants are carried, rocked, soothed, and encouraged to explore our developmentally appropriate play area. Individual needs are recognized and accommodated. An infant's day will include music, finger play, books, cooperative play, and one-to-one adult interaction in a safe, clean environment. Outdoor exploration will also be provided.



**Toddlers:** Caregivers will encourage social and emotional development through music, dance, and individual and small group play. They will also develop each child's cognitive, physical, and language skills with stimulating and engaging activities. Caregivers will create an environment that is conducive to exploration and discovery. Separate play areas will accommodate varying needs and levels of ability. Outdoor play will be encouraged as much as possible.

**Pre-K:** Teachers and assistants will create a learning environment that is appropriate for a variety of abilities and needs. Caregivers will be warm and loving and instruction will be whole group, small group, and individualized. The NYS Learning Standards will be achieved through creative experiences that allow for all children to reach their full potential. The curriculum and activities will be stimulating, diverse, and support students in all areas of development. PreK 4 follows UPK guidelines and uses Scholastic's PreK On My Way curriculum.
