Congratulations to our PHS winter guards on their performances this past weekend at the Texas Color Guard Circuit State Championships. The Pearland HS teams claimed the top 2 spots on the team leaderboard, with Pearland Varsity 1 shooting a team score of 646, and Pearland Varsity 2 shooting a team score of 768. For Individual Gross, PHS Girls grabbed the top 7 spots on the leaderboard, and all 9 girls finished inside the top 13. Carina Benavides finished 3rd with a 2 day score of 172, Landry Poulin finished second with a 2 day score of 153, and our 23-6A district champion, with a 2 day score of 147, is Samantha Truong. TOMORROW - On Tuesday, April 9, 2024, we will administer the STAAR English I and STAAR English II End-of-Course exam to all students enrolled in English I and/or English II and those that have not been successful on previous administrations of English I and/or English II.

- All English I/English II students will report to their testing room at regular time, 7:15 am. Room assignments are posted in the Bullard Commons, Searcy Cafeteria and the Searcy Rounded wall.
- Testing students **will need to bring their district device on the day of the exam**. Devices will need to be **fully charged** and students **need** to bring their chargers.
- Any testing student who travels to Turner High School, needs to report to PHS for the exam.
- All students must bring their school ID.
- Once testing is complete, testing students will move to a modified bell schedule.
- All students **NOT** taking the English I and/or English II STAAR assessments will arrive to campus at 10:30 AM and should initially report to Bullard Cafeteria. Students will follow a modified bell schedule beginning around 12:00 PM for periods 6-7.
- **Bus Transportation will operate at the normal time**. Non-testing students who do not have transportation to arrive at 10:30 AM can ride the bus at the normal time. Non-testing students that arrive to campus will be housed in the Bullard Cafeteria until testing is complete.
- Turner travel will only occur after school for extra-curricular activities.
