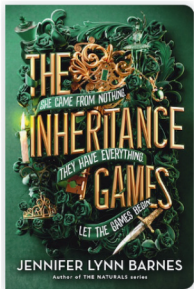

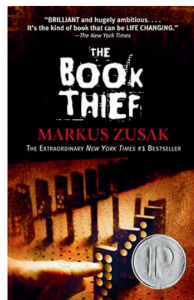
- You are required to read *The Inheritance Games* by Jennifer Lynn Barnes.
