Roughly half of the jobs in this field require specialized training, such as obtaining a certificate or degree. Healthcare professions typically demand knowledge in chemistry, physics, math, and biology, alongside strong communication, problem-solving, and critical thinking abilities.

According to the Workplace Investment Board of Tulare County, in 2023, there were a total of 102,543 jobs in the Fresno, Tulare, and Kings County region, and nearly 30 percent of those jobs were in the Individual and Family Services industry. Top programs in our area include Fresno City College, San Joaquin Valley College, California Health Sciences University and Fresno State.


