PHILOSOPHY

Saint Ann Catholic School's fundamental purpose is to promote the Catholic Church's teachings and instill in its students a profound and personal spirituality. The school seeks to provide a unique setting where spiritual, academic, emotional, social, and physical growth is realized within our faith community. The faith community is strengthened and nourished by active participation in liturgy and prayer. The school develops Catholic values and attitudes within its students, faculty, and staff and emphasizes our responsibility to bring Christ to others.

Academically, students are afforded the opportunity to advance their individual abilities and to realize their unique talents. This is accomplished by the faculty and staff being responsive to the needs of the students, empowering them with skills and factual knowledge that stimulate creative thinking, and uniting the Christian community in prayer, work, and love. Our pursuit for academic excellence is strengthened by our common love for lesus Christ and the deepening of our children's faith and trust in God.

Education is one of the most important ways the Church fulfills its obligation to the person's dignity and the building of community by nurturing a commitment to serve others. Saint Ann Catholic School echoes the words of the United States bishops' document To Teach as Jesus Did: "Proclaiming the Gospel is a perennial task and joy for the Church of Jesus Christ. Rarely, if ever, has it been more pressing a need, more urgent a duty, and more ennobling a vocation than in these times when mankind stands poised between unprecedented fulfillment and equally unprecedented calamity. SPIRITUALITY

Goals include: No child should ever be denied a Catholic Education due to a lack of resources; to employ the brightest and best faculty to educate the students entrusted to our care; to support academic, athletic, and extracurricular programs of Saint Ann Catholic School; and, to endow all the above purposes.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM WITH TECHNOLOGY INTEGRATION

Saint Ann Catholic School's Academic Program prioritizes holistic education, aligning with the standards of the Diocese of Venice and the state of Florida while instilling traditional Catholic values. Educators create a nurturing yet challenging learning environment spanning language arts, math, science, and social studies through best teaching practices like differentiated instruction and technology integration.

Teachers exceed curriculum standards using various instructional methods, including project-based learning and individualized instruction. The school's STREAM initiative integrates science, technology, religion, engineering, the arts, and math at all levels, while daily Spanish classes up to grade 7 and virtual schooling for grade 8 broaden cultural horizons. To enrich learning further, Saint Ann Catholic School provides a 1:1 iPad program in grades 5 - 8, promoting immediate access to information and enhancing collaboration. The school's modern media center, equipped with an iMac computer lab and 3D printer, improves students' technological proficiency inside and outside the classroom.

Notable strengths include growing enrollment and financial stability, which are pivotal for long-term viability. The school maintains a strong reputation, drawing families with its Catholic curriculum, small classes, community spirit, and safety focus. The school actively invests in enrollment management, infrastructure, and maintenance, ensuring financial stability and empowering the school to flourish amidst evolving circumstances.

Perspectives on education have shifted, presenting an exciting opportunity for Saint Ann Catholic School. With the implementation of the universal voucher program in Florida, all students now have access to tax-backed vouchers, regardless of income. This extension of eligibility from kindergarten to grade 12 in public and private schools gives families more educational choices than ever. A significant aspect of this initiative is the provision of generous scholarships, with families receiving substantial financial support. For example, families with students in grades K-3 receive \$9554 per student, and grades 4-8 get \$8885 per student. This means the tuition for most of the Saint Ann families is covered.

Saint Ann Catholic School offers ample opportunities for a new principal to lead and make a meaningful impact. Driven by its strong Catholic identity, academic excellence, growing Enrollment, and commitment to student development, the school is poised for continued growth and success. The school looks to the future with opportunities to enhance its offerings and maintain its role as a beacon of educational excellence and spiritual growth in the community.

- Must pass Level II Fingerprinting and complete Safe Environment.
