Contact TSVI & O&M to discuss data

VI REED/Re-evaluation One At-A-Glance



Step 1

Prior to due date, the TSVI will get consent to obtain an updated eye medical

Step 2



The TSVI and O&M Specialist will review eye medical and fill out REED form to determine the need for a new evaluation. If a new evaluation is not recommended based on the ARD committee decision, skip to Step 4.

*Must also get consent for O&M evaluation for re-evaluation, EVEN if student did not previously qualify. O&M must always be considered after initial evaluation

Step 3



If recommended the TSVI and O&M Specialist will conduct new evaluations.*

Step 4



The TSVI and O&M Specialist will upload eye medical, and input appropriate information into district IEP program.
