Strategic Plan Goal 1: Success in the Early Years

Outcome C: Increased percentage of children meeting or exceeding grade level standards by the end of Grade 3.

Academic Gap Goal: Overall Reading Risk for K-2 students identified as Low Income will reduce from 54% in Spring of 2023 to 75%, reducing the current gap between Non-Low-Income peers to 10% or less, by Spring of 2024 as measured by Easy CBM Benchmark assessments.

Indicators of Progress:

-Currently 66% of students identified as low income in grades K-2 are showing low risk on benchmark assessments compared to only 54% in Spring of last year showing great progress towards our goal of 75% or more by Spring of 24.



Concern Area:

-Only 45% 2nd graders identified as low income are showing low risk on Winter Benchmark assessments compared to 86% of their non-low income peers.

Next Steps:

- Continued implementation of ECRI routines in classrooms and intervention throughout K-2
- LAP, Resource, MLL targeted instruction to support goals for students showing some or high risk particularly in 2nd grade.
- Daily in class small group and 1:1 instruction for all students showing some risk.
- Data cycles for analyzing, collaborating, and fine-tuning instruction throughout the Spring.
- Regular progress monitoring of 2nd grade students showing some or high risk on easy CBM and in class assessments.

Strategic Plan Goal 2: Responsible, Resilient, Empowered Learners.

Outcome B: Increased percentage of regular school attenders.

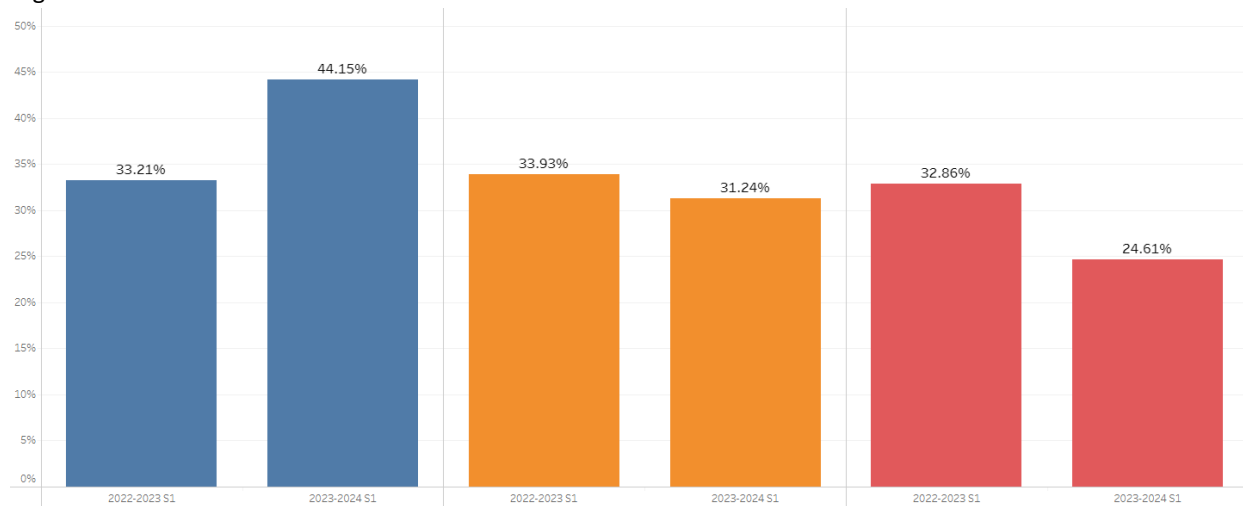
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Behavior or Social Emotional Gap Goal: Chronic and At-Risk attendance rates will decrease from 69% in Spring of 2023 to pre-COVID rates of 45% or lower by Spring of 2024 as measured by district attendance data.

Indicators of Progress:

-44% of K-5 students were regular attenders in Semester 1 of 23-24 school year compared to only 33% of K-5 being identified as regular attenders in Semester 1 of 22-23.



Concern Area:

-Regular attendance rates are still dropping from September of 2023 from 58% regular attenders to January of 2024 only 39% regularly attending.

Next Steps:

- Attendance team will focus on students dropping into Chronic category moving into 2nd semester.
- Rewards and celebrations focused on regular attendance.
- Offer individual supports through team for teachers, students, and families: student incentive plans.
- Admin/ Counselor communication weekly with families struggling to attend via email, phone, or meeting.
- Invite teachers to participate in reaching out to families about attendance.
- Increase data shared with families about regular attendance in Monthly Newsletters.
