All K-5 elementary schools offer strong curriculum that is adapted to the individual learning needs of students. E-STEM is supported through daily activities, annual E-STEM Festivals, the week-long, 5th grade trip to Wolf Ridge Environmental Learning Center in Finland, MN, as well as school gardens. Thanks to community partners and innovative teachers, students in grades 3-5 may apply to be in the popular Junior Naturalist program.

All elementary schools create positive classroom environments by teaching students the social skills of C.A.R.E.S. (Cooperation, Assertion, Responsibility, Empathy and Self-Control) where social-emotional and academic learning combine to encourage children and increase academic achievement.

Families have the option to choose a K-5 Spanish Immersion experience at La ola del lago at Grainwood. The district also offers full-time, gifted instruction for students in grades 3-5 at SAGE Academy (School for the Advancement of Gifted Education), located inside WestWood Elementary.

ATLAS Hidden Oaks Middle School Twin Oaks Middle School

Hidden Oaks and Twin Oaks are partner schools located across the street from each other. Because of their close proximity, staff at each site work together to benefit students by creating class opportunities and electives that could only be offered by the two schools working together.

The middle schools offer advanced classes in English, Math, Science and Social Studies. Spanish immersion continues in middle school, along with French and German introductory course options. Our middle schools have a wide variety of additional elective offerings from which to choose including art, band, choir, family and consumer science, physical education, business, computer science, tech ed and more.

Students can participate in a variety of leadership groups such as Student Council, Where Everyone Belongs (W.E.B.) and our environmental education club, Earth Link. All 8th grade students have the opportunity to go on a trip to Washington D.C. in the fall.

Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) are practiced to establish positive student culture and to create a safe learning environment for all students.

ATLAS (Achieve to Learn Academic Success) offers small class sizes and unique instructional approaches for students in grades 7-8 who might struggle in a traditional school setting.

Prior Lake High School offers many innovative programs such as tech ed, EcoTeam and our small-scale Fabrication Laboratory, Fab Lab. Students also have a wide variety of AP and Honors courses from which to choose.

Juniors and seniors can apply to MNCAPS (Minnesota Center for Advanced Professional Studies), a program that immerses students in profession-based learning while earning high school and college credits. Some of the pathway options include business, health care, trades and more.

Bridges Area Learning Center

Bridges Area Learning Center staff work to reach all learners - especially those who struggle in a traditional school setting. This alternative high school program offers personalized instruction with staff who have a flexible approach to teaching.
