3. **Approve Minutes from Previous Meeting on February 12, 2024** - Brandi Richardson made a motion to approve minutes. DJ Yarbrough seconded the motion. Minutes from the February meeting were approved.
4. **Recap of the 23-24 School Year Successes** - The Council discussed the many successes in social emotional learning this school year, including 180 Degrees, Abigail's Arms Healthy Relationships, Abigail's Arms Not a Number, the Choose Love Movement, and CASA presentations.
The random drug screenings are ongoing at Muenster ISD per Mr. Sewell. Brandi Richardson reported to the council that all required health screenings are complete and will be reported to the state, as required. CPR training for all 9th grade students and any new students to the district is scheduled for April 25, 2024. This training will be conducted by Nurse Richardson on the HS campus. Nurse Richardson reported that Puberty education was completed for 5th grade students that opted-in in March. Optional Stop the Bleed instruction/ training has been offered to all students in grades 7-12. Once the students have completed the online instruction portion of the course, they will provide a certificate of

completion to Nurse Richardson in order to complete the hands-on skills portion of the course. Nurse Richardson also reported that Muenster ISD is holding a vaccination clinic on April 18, 2024 in collaboration with the Texas Department of State Health Services. This vaccination clinic will be offered to all current 6th grade students, as well as Juniors and Seniors.

The elementary students at MISD participated in the Kids Heart Health Challenge.

In another note, Nurse Richardson informed the council that she has completed the required course of instruction for seizure management and treatment in schools.

5. **Discuss Tucker's Law HB3908** - Shelley Wylie reviewed some of the requirements of Tucker's Law with the members of the SHAC in order to ensure that all required education is being provided to the students at MISD.
6. **Discuss a Workshop for 24-25 goals - inclusive of parent awareness, possible student liaisons, including more of the community and Sacred Heart** - Shelley Wylie laid out a plan to members of hosting a workshop to discuss goals for the upcoming 2024-2025 school year. She would like to use this as an opportunity to reach out the community and to encourage more parent and community involvement in the SHAC. This would provide an opportunity for parent awareness and input. She also discussed the possibility of including student liaisons on next year's council. She would also like to explore the possibility of partnering with our neighboring school for educational opportunities. The date and time for the upcoming workshop is TBD.
7. **New meeting times and locations for 24-25 school year** - Shelley Wylie stated that she would be sending out a poll via email to members in regards to the best time and location for meetings during the 24-25 school year. A time will be chosen that works best for the majority of members. It was discussed that the administration building may be the best place for all future meetings.
