

## Listen up, everyone... stay safe while you are a pedestrian by following the rules.

- Always wear light color clothing.
- Always use a sidewalk if there is one.
- If there is no sidewalk, always walk on the left side of the road, facing traffic. If someone is with you, walk single file.
- NEVER walk in the road.
- Always move further to the left or stop when a vehicle approaches.
- Always stay alert and pay attention to your surroundings... texting or talking on your phone, listening to your music player, or playing a handheld video game are distractions that could lead to injury.
- Always stop at the curb to look and listen for vehicles before crossing the road.
- Always look left, right, and left again before crossing the road.
- NEVER assume that the driver of a vehicle sees you.
- Always communicate with drivers by making eye contact. It's okay to wave, too.
- Always be on time to the bus stop.
- NEVER run toward or around any vehicles.
- NEVER play in the road or on railroad tracks.
- NEVER stand, walk behind, or play behind any vehicle.
- NEVER stand in the road while waiting to be picked up.
- Always go straight home from the bus stop.
- NEVER walk too close to the roadway. Remember, the mirrors on large vehicles extend beyond the width of the vehicle (commercial vehicles such as buses, trucks, road maintenance vehicles, etc.).
