Weekly homework:


- Reading Nightly for 20 minutes. Log it in the reading log in blue folder.

Any notes or excuses that need to be given to the school or myself should be sent in your child's blue folder. I check it daily!


Homework should be done neatly and to the best of your child's ability.

BEHAVIOR POLICY




We will be using Class Dojo for behavior management. Students receive immediate feedback on their behaviors both positive and negative. Students are able to “cash out” the positive points they have earned for fun surprises and gifts.






ACADEMIC EXPECTATIONS




At Burnside we have 3 learners dispositions. Those are resiliency, perseverance and a growth mindset.

1. I want them to bounce back when they make a mistake. Mistakes are learning opportunities.

PARENT COMMUNICATION




- Class Dojo
