The goal is to transition students back to their home school with a plan that will aid in decreasing suspensions, reducing the number of students being recommended to the hearing board, and improving their overall academics outcome. R.E.S.E.T uses a positive behavior model with clear and consistent expectations to create a safe learning environment where progress on social and academic goals will occur for all children.

TARGETED POPULATION:

- Students who are over-age for grade level

- Any student 1-2 grade levels behind targeted graduation date
- Students needing smaller learning environment

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Be enrolled in and attend a Richland One middle or high school
- Must complete the application and interview process
- Students needing to receive one or more credits for on-time graduation or acceleration into correct grade level

The Evening High School is designed to serve Richland One students interested in obtaining a high school diploma, but due to life circumstances have dropped out of school or are unable to attend school during the day. This high school is not an alternative school; it is a high school that operates at an

alternative time. The school's target population:

- previous year and current year dropouts with preference given to 12th graders
- students not eligible to enroll in the Adult Education Program
- referrals from the Hearing Office
- students who need one or two courses to meet graduation requirements
- diploma track students receiving special education services
- students who prefer a small learning environment

This program operates Monday - Thursday, from 4:00 pm - 8:10 pm on the district academic calendar. This schedule enables students to hold a job, meet family obligations and upon meeting the requirements, graduate from high school
