



Children’s Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) Privacy Notice and “OPT OUT” FORM

Richland County School District One is committed to providing our students with the most effective, educational web-based tools and applications for learning. The **Children’s Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA)** requires parental notification and consent for student use of district approved online resources for students under the age of 13. The law permits the school to act as the parent’s agent and to consent to the collection of student information on the parent’s behalf.

The district utilizes a variety of online assessments and instructional programs to meet your child’s needs. Examples of district selected online resources that your child can access during school and at home include, but are not limited to subject, course or program specific applications. For students to use these programs and services, certain personal information must be provided to the website provider. This information may include student’s name, birth date, and district-issued email address. Richland One is committed to providing only the minimum information required for your child(ren) to access district supported educational applications.
