What will you be required to perform at tryouts?

- Dance (taught at first 3 days of tryouts)
- 2 Cheers (taught at first 3 days of tryouts)
- 2 jumps (taught at first 3 days of tryouts)
 - o Toe-touch is required
 - Second jump is jump of choice

What are the judges looking for during tryouts?

It's important to keep in mind that you are not only being judged on the final day of tryouts. The judges will be watching closely every day to get a general sense of who each athlete is and how they could be an asset to the program. A few things judges will be on the lookout for include but are not limited to:

- Facials/smiling
- How you interact with other athletes
- How quickly athletes pick up on material
- General enthusiasm
- Body language/overall attitude
- Willingness to learn/try new things
- Motions (sharpness/tightness)
- Voice projection
- Overall performance
- Appearance
- Timeliness
- Preparedness

If you have specific questions about what judges may be looking for/how you'll be scored at tryouts, please see the official tryout scoresheet that is included in this packet.

What do you need to be eligible for tryouts?

As a Dreher High School Cheerleader, you are responsible for representing yourself, your school, and your coaches, meaning you will be held to very high standards and expectations on AND off the field. This includes social media, events unrelated to Dreher or the cheerleading program, any time you are out in public with DHS Cheer gear on, in the classroom, etc. Please always keep this in mind because this responsibility is taken VERY SERIOUSLY. Below is a list of things that are required to be eligible for tryouts:

- A clean discipline record (no major offenses)
- No excessive tardies or absences
- C average in all of your CORE classes
- No pending debts to the school or cheer program

There are also a few things that you will need to have completed before tryouts on May 2nd. Those include the following:

- An up to date physical dated AFTER 4/1/23 uploaded into Planet High School
- All required forms and documents uploaded and signed in Planet High School
- 2 teacher recommendations
 - o 1 MUST be from a CORE class teacher (math, history, science, English)
 - o A Microsoft Form link will be sent out to all teachers at Dreher and Hand!
 - Send me an email if you need the link for a teacher!
- Meet all requirements in previous list

Please reach out ASAP if you have any questions about eligibility requirements or whether or not you are eligible for tryouts!

What do you need to wear for tryouts?

- Plain white t-shirt or tank top
 - No spaghetti straps/camisoles
 - No writing/graphics
- Sports bra
- Navy blue or black shorts
 - No writing/graphics
 - Not too short
- Athletic tennis shoes (preferably all white)
- White or no show socks
- Hair all the way up or ½ up ½ down (out of face)
- Bow (if you have one)
- ABSOLUTELY NO LONG NAILS OR NAIL POLISH!!
- ABSOLUTELY NO JEWELRY (ears, body, face, etc)

Dreher Cheer Athlete Code of Conduct

As a Dreher Cheerleader, there are certain standards and expectations that must be upheld. By signing this contract you are agreeing to the terms and conditions set forth by the Dreher Cheerleading Coaching Staff. You are eligible for termination at any point in time if you are found in violation of this code of conduct. The rules and expectations for all members of the team are as follows:

- 1. Be on time to all practices, games, and events. This includes being appropriately dressed (i.e. cheer shoes, no jewelry, athletic wear, hair out of your face, etc.). Failure to be prepared will be interpreted as being late.
 - Coaching staff reserves the right to make late athletes run/condition after practices or bench athletes at events.
- 2. Notify coaching staff of any absences at least 24 hours before the missed event. This includes other school related activities such as dance, drama, tutoring, etc. Emergencies will be handled on a case by case basis.
 - Coaching staff reserves the right to bench athletes at events for missed practices.
 - If athletes miss 3 practices, they will be put on probation. If attendance is not improved, they will be benched or removed from the team.
- 3. Communicate with coaching staff and other athletes in a respectful, effective, and positive manner. Coaching staff reserves the right to schedule conferences with athletes/parents or bench athletes at events. If the problem continues, the coaching staff reserves the right to remove the athlete from the team.
- 4. Bring all required materials to all events. (i.e. Warm-Ups, Under armor, poms, shoes, socks, bows, uniforms, spanks, etc.)
 - Coaching staff reserves the right to bench athletes who are not prepared at events.
- 5. Maintain a C average and pass all core classes.
 - Coaching staff reserves the right to place athletes on academic probation. If grades do not improve, athletes can be benched from practices and games or removed from the team.
- 6. Follow all school/district rules and expectations. Behavior issues in school will be addressed by coaching staff as well as administrative staff.
 - Coaching staff reserves the right to address these issues on a case by case basis. Athletes can be benched for practices and events or removed from the team depending on the severity of the discipline issue.
- 7. No PDA, party conversations, talk of violence/fighting, or foul language while at school/cheer events or in any clothes that identify you as a Dreher cheerleader. Social media accounts should also be kept clean.
 - Coaching staff reserves the right to assign consequences if this behavior continues after a verbal warning.
- 8. If a parent/guardian would like to take their athlete home directly from an event, the coaching staff must make contact with the parent/guardian before the athlete will be released. If parents/guardians would like anyone other than themselves to pick their athlete up from an event, a phone call or email must be sent 24 hours in advance or the athlete will not be released. Emergencies will be handled on a case by case basis.
- 9. Remain focused and attentive during practices, games, and other events. This includes minimizing talking, distracting behaviors, and cell phones/smart watches.

Coaching staff reserve the right to assign consequences if these behaviors continue after a verbal warning.

10. Be an active, willing, positive participant of the team.

Coaching staff reserve the right to schedule coach/athlete/parent conferences. If expectations are still not met, athletes can be put on probation or removed from the team.

The consequences for breaking these rules/expectations may vary depending on the degree and frequency of the infraction. Some common/likely consequences have been included with these rules/expectations but the coaching staff has the right to exercise their discretion when handling a breach of this code of conduct.

As a Dreher Cheerleader, you are a representative of the school and must behave as such. By signing this code of conduct, you are agreeing to uphold the expectations that have been established by the coaching staff and accept the consequences for failing to meet these expectations.
