## ConnectED Library Card Partnership | Richland Library and Richland School District One

Richland Library and Richland One have partnered to provide a library card for every student in the district. This project is part of the nationwide initiative: <u>Leaders Library Card Challenge</u>.

**Elementary Students** | Apply for a card online at <u>www.richlandlibrary.com/librarycard</u>. *A parent/guardian must complete the online form for their child if under 13.* 

**Middle and High Students** | A library account has been created for every student using their Student ID number. The PIN for a majority of the student ID accounts is the last four digits of the student ID number. For some students, the PIN is based on the month and day of their birthday (MMDD). For example, using the birthday May 10, the PIN would be 0510.

These accounts do not need to be activated; they are live and ready to be used.

  partnership during school registration. Accounts were not created for students who "opted
  out". If these students do want a library card, they can apply for one using our online form:

  account.
- The PIN for a majority of the student ID accounts is the last four digits of the student ID number. For some students, the PIN is based on the month and day of their birthday (MMDD).
   For example, using the birthday May 10, the PIN would be 0510. Students may change their PIN by calling 803.799.9084 and providing their Student ID number and birthdate.
