3. **Principal's Update, PP video presented:**
 - Reviewed School Data:**
 - a. 100% Students Passed EOC in Algebra I which is above the district average.
 - b. Hearing Board Referrals have been reduced by 21-23 referrals during 2015-2016 school year.
 - c. Current enrollment is 353 students.
 - Additional Information:**
 - a. W. A. Perry is planning 60th Anniversary celebration.
 - b. Student Incentives include - Eagle of the Month – Perfect Attendance Awards.
 - c. SIC/PTO are planning fundraiser to purchase a Digital Sign for W. A. Perry.
 - d. A Mock Trial Team has been developed by Ms. Roundtree - Students are excited.
 - e. Social media is being utilized to publicize school events and accomplishments.
 - f. Co-Teaching has been implemented to strengthen student achievement. One content area is currently participating (Math).
 - g. Community Partnerships such as Trinity Cathedral is flourishing.
 - New Programs:**
 - h. Capturing Kids Hearts (Building Relationships between teachers and students) is a professional training that all faculty will be required to attend.
 - i. Restorative Justice is a program designed to reduce Hearing Board referrals and improve student behavior through students working together as peer counselors and peer evaluators of behaviors in hearings that are managed and directed by students.
 - Additional Information:**
 - j. Cooling with Coltrain is a PBIS incentive initiative that was “a hit” with the students. Students who were recommended for outstanding behavior and show of good character were presented with ice-cream by Principal Coltrain.
 - k. Blue jean Day and College Color Day are other sponsored events to boost school spirit.
 - l. “Blue Jean passes” are issued to staff who attend extracurricular events to support students during after-school hour events. The faculty incentive is a “major hit.”
