Curriculum

Eau Claire High School offers a multi-level instructional program, which includes Dual Enrollment at Midlands Technical College, Advanced Placement Program (AP), Honors Program, College Preparation Program (College Prep), and Special Education Program. Students may qualify for academic college credit by enrolling in Dual Enrollment courses and passing the corresponding exams in the following areas: Advanced Placement Literature, Advanced Placement Chemistry, Advanced Placement Calculus and Advanced Placement US History. Students with special needs and disabilities are placed in special education classes according to their disabilities. Additionally, we provide diagnostic and remedial services, as well as credit recovery (Edgenuity) to our students.

Honors and Awards

- Six Eau Claire High School students were recognized as Richland One Academic All-Stars. These numbers continue to increase each year.
- A student was awarded “Outstanding Senior” by Trio.
- Two students qualified for the Palmetto Teaching Fellows Scholarship
- Three students qualified as Art Scholars.
- Five students were inducted into the Eau Claire High School National Honor Society



Student Assessments

- Algebra I EOCE had a 28.8% passage rate.
- English II EOCE had a 65.8% passage rate
- Biology I EOCE had a 17.9% passage rate
- US History EOCE had a 33.6 passage rate
- Graduation Rate **increased** from 79.1 % to 84.1 %
- 80 Students were recognized for being College or Career Ready..



Other Notable Achievements

- The CDL Program received a \$100,000 truck simulator to develop the skills of students.
- Student ranked #4 in 2A Wrestling at 138lbs
- The boys basketball team made it to the 3rd round Region 3 AA Basketball playoffs
- Students selected to participate in both Regional and State Honor bands and orchestras.
- Students selected to serve as state officers for the FCCLA.
- Three football players earned AA Region IV, All Region Honors.
