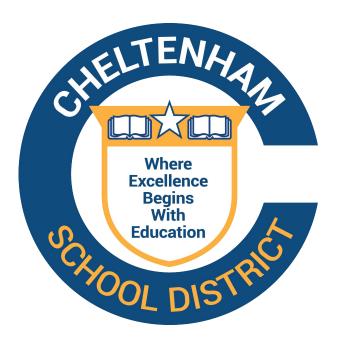

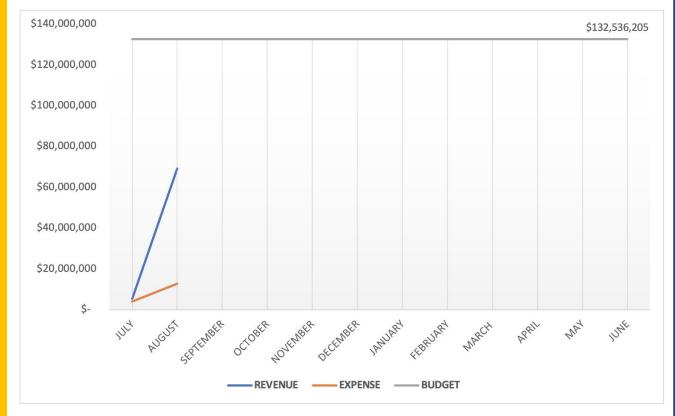

# SOUTHEASTERN PENNSYLVANIA SCHOOLS TRUST SEPAST

- Self-insured medial and prescription insurance trust consisting of school District in Montgomery County Pennsylvania
  - Claims incurred are expensed to each corresponding district
  - Managed through Independence Blue Cross contracts
  - Prescription managed through Capital Rx
- SEPAST is run by School Board approved District trustees consisting of members of management at each school District
- Dental separately insured
