With a clear connection between the classroom and the world, the Cheltenham School District will strive for excellence by:


- 1. inspiring our students to develop principled and knowledgeable responses to the local, national, and global challenges of the 21st century;

Administration Building Projects

Backflow Installation

- Each year the school district is required to submit an annual backflow inspection report to assure that we are in compliance with AQUA water safety standards
- Backflow prevention devices stop water backup. It is designed to keep water inside the systems, flowing in one direction—from the water main into the pipes. This will keep pipe water from flowing into the water main





The Administration building is the only location throughout the district that is not equipped with this device. As a result, Hirschberg Mechanical was on site to satisfy this requirement and deficiency. This is located in the rear of the building.





Administration Renovations

- Renovations are still in progress in Room 101 and should completed over the next few weeks
- The Facilities Dept. has installed new drop ceilings and energy efficient LED panels
- New carpeting and window treatments will be installed








Roofing Project

- The roof decking and slate shingles have deteriorated due to age of the roof
- This problem has created water infiltration and caused damage in many areas of the building
- This roof will need to be replaced in the future








United States Roofing has replaced several of the cracked slates and installed new membranes with water proof sealant







Cheltenham High School Projects

Fire Alarm System

- Over the past year, the fire alarm system has experienced several communication malfunctions which has prevented it from operating properly. There has been several repairs to the system, however it continues to be a safety hazard of our students and faculty
- The fire alarm system was installed over 25 years ago and parts have become obsolete. Therefore, the entire system will need to be replaced
- On Tuesday, March 21, 2023, a bid advertisement was placed in several Montgomery and Bucks County newspapers. The walkthrough of the building for this project was April 4, 2023. The bid opening is scheduled for April 12 at 10AM



The scope of work will include the following:

- Replacement of all strobes, horns and pull stations
- New fire panels, detectors, and all other ancillary devices will be replaced
- The new system will be in compliance with the NFPA(*National Fire Protection Association*) code and standards
- The results of this bid will be provided at the next facilities committee meeting

Library Dual Temperature Repair


Corrections were made to the system from the original installation during the library renovation project

Elkins Park School Renovations


- The STEM room at Elkins Park is in the process of being converted into an art classroom.
- The Facilities Department is in the process of removing all carpeting, installing new vinyl floor tiles and deep basin sinks. This room will also be painted








This classroom is completed and ready for student occupancy


Work Order System
