

Resolution #36 — Recommended: BE IT RESOLVED that upon recommendation of Superintendent Eleanor Tritt, the Amagansett School Board hereby authorizes the President of the Board to sign the attached Stipulation of Settlement.

Resolution #37 — Recommended: BE IT RESOLVED that upon recommendation of Superintendent Eleanor Tritt, the Amagansett School Board hereby changes Dr. Thomas Lamorgese's title from Independent Evaluator to Interim Administrator commencing retroactively to August 12, 2015 and terminating on or before June 30, 2016.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Board is hereby authorized to execute the revised formal employment contract for Dr. Lamorgese incorporating his new title of Interim Administrator, which will replace Dr. Lamorgese's August 12, 2015 Employment Contract for Independent Evaluator that was approved on August 11, 2015.

Resolution #38 — Recommended: BE IT RESOLVED that upon recommendation of Superintendent Eleanor Tritt, the Amagansett School Board hereby appoints JACQUELINE KUCERA, to the part-time position of Spanish Teacher (.6 FTE) for the period retroactive to September 22, 2015 through on or before June 30, 2016. NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that upon recommendation of Superintendent Eleanor Tritt, the Amagansett School Board of Education hereby approves and ratifies the District's October 6, 2015 submission of the APPR Hardship Waiver application to the State Education Department; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board hereby ratifies the execution of the application by the Superintendent of Schools and Board President.
