Each of the three vacancies upon the Board of Education will be filled at large. The two candidates receiving the largest number of votes shall be elected to three-year terms from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2020. The candidate receiving the third largest number of votes shall be elected to fill the vacancy from the unexpired term of May 16, 2017 through June 30, 2018.

- Documentation illustrating that you are receiving public assistance benefits at a physical address within the district.
